

Native son and West Las Vegan Uri Clinton is a fine, upstanding young man. I took an immediate liking to the tall, thin, gangly, bespectacled and very personable young man when he worked in my office one summer before going to college. We've been fast friends ever since. Having acquired his undergraduate degree, he entered the prestigious Gonzaga University Law School last fall in Spokane, Washington.

My wife and I sent him a care package a few weeks back and he was ecstatic about receiving it. Not long ago Uri called on the phone. From the insistent tone of his voice, I could tell he was very concerned and that something was bothering him.

"Ray, they're trying to get me and the other three Black law students here," he said. At first it didn't dawn on me what he was talking about. It didn't take me long though, to put it all together. As he explained, an anonymous group called the Law Students for a Pure America was trying through fear and intimidation to get rid of the African American students on campus.

The so-called anonymous "group" wrote a letter to each of the four Black students. The explicit letter had an ominous tone and contained racial epithets. Racially inflammatory language was intentionally used to intimidate the students. The students took the letter seriously, and immediately perceived it to be a direct threat to their personal safety.

In short order, the Spokane Police Department and school officials launched an official investigation. Meanwhile, the students targeted by the letter banded together for their mutual safety and protection. They sponsored a rally. The entire student body and many Spokane townspeople came.

Uri said he had an eerie feeling at the rally not knowing if the persons responsible were there or not. Then it happened again. Another letter was placed in the campus mailbox slot of each Black

Following some are key excerpts from the letter, which addressed them each by name and also as "token niggers":

"How did you like your moment of glory... a rally for monkeys. A pure America is our goal and we are going to start with a pure law school. Scholarships should go to deserving whites not to niggers the administration purchases.

"Now if any of you niggers need some help in leaving we will be glad to assist all of you. Now do not make the mistake of thinking this is just a hoax or we only want to intimidate you jerks...we are giving all of you a chance to leave on your own...if not we will assist...We know where you live and we have your schedules...we have watched all of you outside of school...who wants to be first (names the four students and refers to the child of one student as a little monkey).

"Be careful...keep in mind all of you niggers had a chance to leave...accidents do happen. Signed, Law Students for a Pure America...a White America...a Real America!!!!!"

As the story continues to unfold at this moment, the F.B.I. has joined in the investigation

Meanwhile, it's back to the books at Gonzaga for Uri and his fellow schoolmates. Finals week begins May 1.

Isn't it a shame that Black people still have to endure this type of abuse regardless of our age or situation in life?

Kind of scary that in the year 1995 Black folk especially are exposed to the soft underbelly of raw, naked racism in the country we call home. Seems like there's never any comfort level or comfort zone for us - no matter what we do.

To know is to grow. Until next week.
