The recent untimely death of my colleague and friend, former television newsman Paul Dawkins, provided the occasion for me to reflect on the history and status of the African American television journalist in Las Vegas. The conclusion that I have draw is that Black males need not apply.

Dating back to the 1970s, Dawkins, Roosevelt Toston and I were among the first African American regulars reporting on local TV newscasts. It was our Golden Age. In our heyday, I even hosted and produced a Black show called "Minor Key" on Channel 3 that aired just before "Soul Train."

Dawkins left the TV news business in the '80s and was a real estate agent at the time of his death. Toston, a longtime sales executive with the Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority, was a reporter on Channels 3 and 8. While at Channel 3, I became the first ever Black TV News Director in African American male reporters Nevada.

I had been on staff at Channel 3 news a scant few days back in the '70s when I ran into Toston at an NAACP function and to my surprise he told me he had been


let go the Friday before I started working there. No one at the station had told me about Toston. But, as capable as he was a reporter, Toston soon landed a job at Channel 8. We carried on a friendly personal rivalry to see who could scoop the other, especially on community-based stories, for several years.

A few years later, when Otis Harris left the Convention Authority, Toston was hired to replace him. That's when Dawkins saw the opportunity to get on board at Channel 8 News. Those were the days indeed.

Today there are several Black faces on the air. Two of them, Rikki Cheese and Juana Hart, occupy prestigious news anchor slots at their respective stations. Several others are topnotch reporters whose faces we have grown accustomed to seeing as they give us inclusive news reported with confidence and authority on a regular basis.

But, sadly there are no or news anchors at all in Las Vegas today. I for one am gratified to see a solid Black presence in the TV reporting ranks locally. But it is deplorable

Believe me, I have no objection to whatever an individual decides to believe in. If you want to believe that black folks are descendants from the devil, that is fine. However, when you start to act on that belief, there is a problem. Whether it is belief in the so-called "mud people" or that the federal government is about to come to your homes and seize all of your ill-gotten, semi-automatic weapons, and weapons of mass destruction, you have a right to

that belief. However, when you blow up office buildings killing hundreds of people, that creates a problem. The bombing of the federal office building in Oklahoma City is not an isolated incident. It is a carefully calculated strategic plan to compel everyone in this country to believe as the sacrilegious right believes.

They are using proven techniques - terror. If you terrorize people enough, you can convert them to any religion. Ask the early settlers of this country and the colonial conquerors of most of the Third World. It does indeed work, unless someone stands up and says..."Enough, No More!" I haven't heard it. I haven't heard Billy Graham say anything. I haven't heard any of the other so-called "main stream"

What about the folks who are sitting on their hands here in Las Vegas. Where are all of these so-called religious leaders? Why are they so silent? Why aren't they speaking out against the excesses of the Religious Right? I don't quite understand. Where are the religious leaders comments on the plans hatched by the Religious Right in terms of the specific destruction of the African and Latino communities i.e. Weed & Seed? I haven't heard them comment on that. In fact, some of those in the mainstream are cooperating with the Religious Right to their etemal shame.

The point is, as has been made before in this column, it is no different to discern who are your friends and who are your enemies? If folks are not condemning the Weed & Seed program, they are part of the problem. If they have accepted the few pieces of silver issued by the Weed & Seed program to sell out their community, they are part of the problem.

It is time for others to take the lead and begin to speak out. For it is clear that the religious leadership is either powerless, or is so cowardly that they can't speak out. We have to remember who these folks are, and if they continue with their silence, their credibility has to be questioned. It is clearly time for the community at large to begin to let these folks know what's up. It is equally clear that whatever is up, that these folks ain't a part
