# SENIOR AND DISABLED CITIZENS CAT DIAL-A-RIDE TRANSPORTATION

The Regional Transportation Commission of Clark County (RTC) offers the community a much expanded dial-a-ride, or paratransit, transportation system for disabled persons and senior citizens as part of the Citizens Area Transit (CAT) system.

## SENIORS UPDATE DRIVING SKILLS

Pre-registration is required for people 55 and older to attend "55 Alive" AARP's two-day refresher driving course at the Las Vegas Senior Citizens Center, 450 E. Bonanza Rd.

The course is offered twice monthly. Daytime sessions and evening sessions available, call for dates and times. The course is designed for drivers who experience age-related physical changes, such as declining perceptual skills. highlights

include "rules of the road" review, local driving hazards, and accident-prevention measures.

All automobile insurance companies in Nevada provide premium reductions to graduates of "55 Alive."

Payment will not be accepted at the door. The cost is \$8 and pre-registration must be made by calling 792-4091. Classes are limited to 30 people.

Persons who establish with the RTC their eligibility as disabled under the Americans With Disabilities Act, even temporarily, will be eligible for rides whenever they call for a reservation.

However, all persons 65 years and older, even if they many not be aware they may qualify with an ADA disability, should call to reserve a ride. CAT paratransit personnel will help with the very simple disability eligibility certification process.

The RTC wants to assure readers that no person 65 years or older will be refused a ride on the CAT paratransit service simply because they have not yet established disability eligibility.

# What Is Probate? Why Is It Necessary?

As long as there's property, people will dispute its ownership - and property left by a loved one is no exception. Probate evolved through the centuries as a way to minimize tugs-of-war over property left after a death. "Probate" means "prove"; in probate someone - usually the executor proves that the will was validly drawn, signed and witnessed.

The heirs aren't the only ones interested in the recently departed's property. Creditors want the money owed them, the

government wants its taxes, the attorney and executor want their fees.

The executor files the will in probate court, which approves the executor or administrator. Letters go to the heirs and relatives, and notices go in newspapers so creditors can make their claims. The executor pays valid claims, bills and expenses, taxes and fees. After all this the executor distributes what's left to the heirs named in the will, or if there is not a will, to

heirs that state names.

The notices and hearings may take up to a year for a simple estate, for a complex one, several years. Also, attorney and executor fees for handling a \$200,000 estate could easily run more than \$10,000.

Not all property goes through probate. Life insurance, property in a trust, property held in joint tenancy and "pay-on-death" accounts go directly to the named beneficiaries without probate, its delays or fees.
