SOLICITATION FOR PROPOSALS FOR NATIVE AMERICAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DBE) SUPPORTIVE SERVICES

The State of Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) is seeking the services of a professional organization to provide supportive services to Native American firms interested in working on NDOT projects. We intend to contract for the services for a 12 month period beginning from the date of award.

Types of services to be provided for are as follows:

1. Training and technical assistance to otherwise qualified economically and socially disadvantaged Native American firms for attaining a contracting license.
2. Solicitation and encouragement of Native Americans to participate in all facets of NDOT contracting activity.
3. Assistance to such firms in obtaining financial assistance, bonding and prequalification.
4. Assistance to those firms in estimating and bidding.
5. Assistance to project management areas including scheduling, safety, labor compliance, etc.
6. Assistance to NDOT personnel in the utilization of Native American businesses in the major, minor and miscellaneous contracting areas.
7. On-site reviews of Certified Indian firms and applicants for certification in accordance with Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 23.

To be considered, proposals must contain methodology, experience in similar types of programs, estimate of cost, your firm's affirmative action plan commitments. Monthly reporting procedures containing sufficient statistical data and narrative content to enable NDOT to evaluate both progress and problem areas. For example, the monthly report must contain progress in achieving goals and problem areas encountered in meeting these goals. An itemized cost estimate. The cost breakdown must indicate the number of employees, position classification, race and sex, their salaries, amount of time, office location, working hours, expenses, etc. The proposal shall provide for supportive services statewide.

All proposals must adhere to the following stipulations:

- A. The contract will be for one year.
- B. The contract amount cannot exceed \$80,162.00.
- C. Geographic area of coverage: Entire State of Nevada.
- D. The non-discrimination provision required by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 as set forth in FHWA-1273 and a statement of non-discrimination in employment because of race, color, religion, national origin, sex or handicap.

ATS GUIDEWAY

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The work consists of a concrete guideway linking a new ATS Station at the existing Main Terminal with the proposed Satellite "D" and the mass excavation for the basement of the new Satellite "D". The Guideway supports two tracks to accommodate trains for an Automated Transit System, which includes an aerial segment, an embankment segment, a cut segment, and a tunnel segment.

AERIAL SEGMENT:

The Aerial Segment is approximately 1,150 feet long and consists of two elevated tracks, each supported by precast and cast in place concrete box girders. There is a precast and cast in place concrete emergency walkway between the two tracks. The start of the Aerial Segment is supported on the new ATS Station at the Main Terminal. Elsewhere, they are supported on concrete bents sitting on concrete drilled pier foundations.

EMBANKMENT SEGMENT:

The Embankment Segment is about 210 feet long and follows the Aerial Segment. The tracks are supported on compacted structural fill retained by reinforced concrete retaining walls. Existing pavement shall be removed and compacted fill shall be placed to the existing grade.

CUT SEGMENT:

The Cut Segment is about 340 feet long and connects the Embankment Segment to the tunnel. Reinforced concrete retaining walls are used to provide access to the tunnel.

TUNNEL SEGMENT:

The Tunnel Segment is about 1,470 feet long and is comprised of two sections. One section connects the Cut Segment to the center cell of an existing 3-cell tunnel under Paradise Road. The second section connects the existing tunnel to the Satellite "D" cells at "N" Station 42+71.93 and "S" Station 43+04.97. Both tunnel sections have two cells with the wider cell containing the utilities for Satellite "D".

PUMPING STATION AND
TUNNEL DRAINAGE SYSTEM:

A Pumping Station is located east of the existing tunnel under Paradise Road to intercept surface runoff from the on-grade guideway segments and to handle the water used during a fire in a tunnel.

SERVICE ROAD BRIDGE:

A three-span, two-lane bridge spans Paradise Road just north of the North Portal sunshade of the Paradise Road Tunnel and connects the proposed re-routed Kelly

Lane with the apron area west of Paradise Road. The structural scheme consists of precast prestressed and non-prestressed reinforced concrete box girders covered by a bitumastic wearing surface.

WEST STANDPIPE SYSTEM:
A closed loop west standpipe system provides emergency fire water.

DIESEL GENERATOR FUEL
STORAGE TANK AND PIPING.

UTILITY RELOCATION.

MASS EXCAVATION FOR
THE SATELLITE "D" BASEMENT.
