CAT® ANNOUNCES CHANGES IN ROUTES AND SCHEDULES EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 15TH

Citizens Area Transit is modifying service on several routes effective Sunday, October 15. That's right--the CAT® system is getting even better and planning for the future of Southern Nevada. Some routes are traveling to more places. Some are picking you up more frequently. But all 31 routes still feature comfortable, clean buses so you can relax and travel worry free.

These changes are part of an overall improvement program that will culminate with service enhancements in January, 1996. Check below for a summary of the route changes, then call *CAT®*-RIDE for specific schedule and route information.
