Jazz at Newport '95 to air on PBS stations nationwide

NEW YORK — Jazz at Newport '95, an hour of superb music and beautiful scenery taped at the world-renown JVC Jazz Festival at Newport, RI, will air on Public Broadcasting Service (PBS) stations across the nation beginning in the Los Angeles area and continuing on various affiliates through the Winter.

Jazz At Newport '95 airs locally on Friday, October 20, at 10:00 p.m. on KLVX-TV 10.

Anannual PBS favorite, Jazz
At Newport was taped at Fort
Adams State Park August 1213. This year's film takes viewers
on a leisurely drive through the
town with stops at the opulent
Rosecliff (one of Newport's most
renowned mansions), the
lighthouse, the harbor and
historic Fort Adams State Park.

The 1995 program features performances by Roy Hargrove, Larry Carlton and Lee Ritenour, Thomas Chapin, Dorothy Donegan and The Rite of Strings featuring Stanley Clark, Al Di Meola and Jean-Luc Ponty. Backstage footage and interviews with artists round out the tour of the JVC Jazz Festival - Newport.

"Each year, thousands of music lovers travel to Newport to enjoy a weekend of greatjazz," said George Wein, producer of JVC Jazz Festival - Newport. "Fort Adams State Park boasts a beautiful seaside setting that everyone should experience at least once; however, if that's not possible, the televised version is certainly the next best thing."

Introduced in the summer of 1954, the first Newport Jazz Festival (now known as the JVC Jazz Festival - Newport) was held at the historic Newport Casino, home of the International Tennis Hall of Fame. Now, 41 years later, the event, whose mission was "to encourage America's enjoyment of jazz and to sponsor the study of our country's original art form" has set a standard for jazz festivals all over the world. George Wein conceived the event and continues to expand upon his successful ideas year after year.
