Payment Methods Established for Coin Telephone Calls Using Telecommunications Relay Services (TDS)

If you need to use a coin telephone to make calls through the Nevada Telecommunications Relay Service (TRS), then you need to know about policies that became effective Nov. 24, 1995.

· Local calls from a coin telephone made through the TRS center will be provided at no cost to the person making the call.

 Toll and long distance calls from a coin telephone made through the TRS center can be charged to a calling card and will cost no more than the same call using coins.

TRS centers facilitate calls, both personal and business, between traditional telephone users and people who are deaf, hard of hearing, or speech disabled and use a special communications device (TTY) to communicate over the telephone. These centers are in operation seven days a week, 24 hours a day. The TRS center in Nevada can be reached by calling 1-800-326-6868 for TTY users or 1-800-326-6888 for all other callers.

These policies were issued by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and are supported by Sprint/Central Telephone-Nevada, local and long distance telephone companies, TRS providers and organizations representing people who are deaf, hard of hearing, or speech disabled.

This rule makes no change in the way TRS coin phone calls are presently handled in Nevada.
