Warren Rosegreen becomes Rebels' enforcer

Warren Rosegreen, in his first season with the UNLV Runnin' Rebels, has more than made his presence known on the court. The 6-5, 210 pound forward has slowly become UNLV's enforcer,

a title he's proud to hold. "Warren brings back memories for old Runnin' Rebels fans with his intensity and athletic ability," says UNLV head coach Jim Bayno. "He's relentless on

the glass and attacks opponents on both ends of the court." Relentless isn't the word. In just 10 games this season, Rosegreen has managed to lead the Rebels in rebounding (10.7

per game); he's tied for second in scoring (12.5 points per game); and is second in field goal percentage (.556).

A perfect example of Warren's intensity could be seen when the Rebels hosted defending national champions UCLA at the Thomas & Mack in December. His aggressive style of play netted him 19 points (second to Clayton Johnson's career-high 26 points) and a game high 14 rebounds.

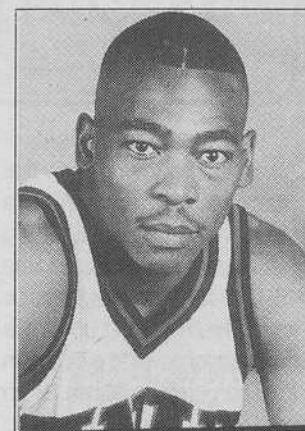
A 1993 graduate of Dillard High School in Ft. Lauderdale, Fla., Warren played football as a wide receiver. As a senior, he was recruited by such football

powers as Clemson, Florida and Miami.

The past two years he has played basketball for Chaffey College in Ontario, Calif. Last season he averaged 17.1 points and 16.4 rebounds per game, while shooting .634 from the field.

As a freshman, Rosegreen earned all-conference honors as Chaffey advanced to the California Junior College Final Four.

A first team all-state and conference selection last season at Chaffey, he led the state in rebounding, setting a California junior college record.

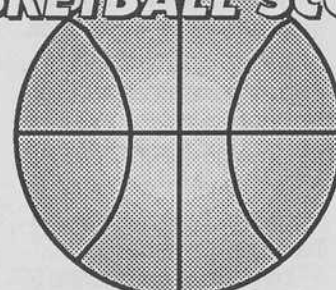
