passes for a total of only 4 first-downs. And even though they managed to put 17 points on the board, their overworked defense barely got a breather — and it caught up with them in the end.

In the AFC title game the Pittsburgh Steelers got a scare as they held off this season's Cinderella team, the Indianapolis Colts, 20-16. In a game which saw the lead see-saw back and forth several times, it almost became a case of *deja vu* for the Steelers as they again found themselves with their backs against the wall in the final minutes of the game.

Just like last season, the Steelers led the AFC Championship Game in the fourth quarter, only to be shocked by a deep touchdown pass. After getting the ball back, they failed to convert on fourth-and-3 and their Super Bowl dreams were shattered.

This time around, however, things worked out a little differently. With only 3:03 remaining and more than 50 yards to the end zone, Steeler quarterback Neil O'Donnell — again on fourth-and-3 — found receiver Andre Hastings down the sidelines for 9 yards and a crucial first down. But it was the very next play that broke the Colts.

Pittsburgh receiver Ernie Mills badly beat defensive back Ashley Ambrose for a 37 yard completion, giving the Steelers a first down on the Colts' 1 yard line. Two plays later, Bam Morris powered his way to a Steeler touchdown for the win.

"Maybe it was poetic justice," said Steelers coach Bill Cowher, of the ironically similar events of the last two seasons. But if that's what it is, it's now time for Pittsburgh to wake up to reality. They now have a different type of justice to face. The kind the Dallas Cowboys deal out.

The Steelers' defense will have their hands full in trying to deal with Dallas' lethal offense, led by Smith, receiver Michael Irvin, and quarterback Troy Aikman.

Dallas, on the other hand, isn't so reliable on defense either, but rarely needs to be. It can make the big plays, especially when Deion Sanders, Darren Woodson and Leon Lett are involved.

Perhaps, for the Steelers, just making it to the Super Bowl has offered redemption from last year when they fell three yards short of making it against San Diego. But knowing they now face the experienced Dallas Cowboys, perhaps their win against the Colts will just have to do...till next year, anyway.
