

Middle School Magnet Program

February through the First Friday in March

Magnet programs offer students opportunities to choose educational experiences based on their special interests and abilities. Magnet programs are helping transform public education by providing outstanding educational programs and by giving students opportunities to share learning experiences with students from different cultures and backgrounds who have similar interests and talents. The Clark County School District is committed to racial and ethnic diversity because the district believes diversity is educationally beneficial for all students. Academic excellence and equal opportunity are major educational goals of magnet programs.

All of the Clark County School District's magnet schools and programs are attended voluntarily by students who choose to apply to magnet programs based on their special interests and talents. Through these magnet schools and programs, Clark County School District is providing unique educational opportunities and achieving progress towards reaching the district's desegregation goals.

Admission Requirements Elementary

Students and parents may choose from the magnet schools offered by the Clark County School District based on interest, talent, and abilities. The open magnet school seats are assigned utilizing a random lottery program. Students not selected are placed on an alternate list. The commitment of the parent/guardian and the child should be for one complete school year in the magnet school.

Secondary Selection Procedures

At the secondary level, entrance criteria have been established for admission to each magnet program as a means of promoting student success. Students interested in applying to a magnet program should speak to their counselor or contact that specific school. Students meeting the criteria for the magnet school(s) are placed into a pool of qualified applications. When the number of qualified students for a magnet school/program exceed the number of seats available, a random selection method will be utilized. In keeping with the district's goals, racial balance is a consideration in selecting students for magnet schools/programs.

It is the policy of the Clark County School District to afford equal opportunity in education to qualified students. If you think you have a disability that may affect your ability to fully participate in any of the District's magnet programs, you are encouraged to provide information about your disability to the review committee at the school(s) to which you have submitted an application so that they may help you develop an accommodation plan. Admissions criteria will not be waived, but accommodations will be made where possible to allow you to meet the requirements, provided that you are timely in working with the committee to develop an accommodation plan.


