## Detroit's Grant Hill Named Top Vote Getter

Even though Michael Jordan is back and tearing through the NBA again, Grant Hill remains the fans' favorite in voting for the NBA's 46th annual All-Star Game to be played Sunday in the Alamodome in San Antonio.

In the closest balloting since 1977, the Detroit Pistons' forward drew the most votes of any player in All-Star fan balloting, edging Jordan by 16,582 votes. Out of more than 6 million votes cast by fans, Hill got 1,358,004 votes to 1,341,422 for Jordan.

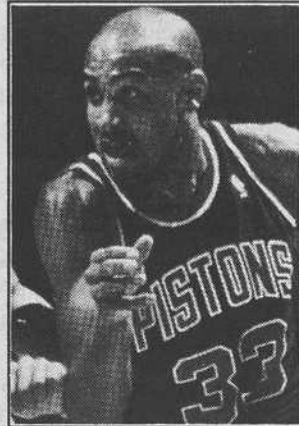
"I just hope that Michael isn't ticked off because I got

more votes than him," Hill said jokingly after the vote totals were announced.

Dallas' Jason Kidd, who shared last season's rookie of the year honors with Hill, was voted in as a Western Conference starter for the Feb. 11 game.

Hill and Jordan will be two of the starters on the Eastern Conference team, joined by Jordan's teammate Scottie Pippen at the other forward spot, Orlando's Shaquille O'Neal at center and Anfernee Hardaway at point guard.

For the West, it will be Kidd at point, Seattle's Shawn Kemp and Phoenix's Charles Barkley at forward, and Houston's Hakeem Olajuwon at center and Clyde

Drexler at shooting guard.

Barkley was the leading vote getter in the Western Conference, drawing 1,268,195 votes, 27,866 more than Olajuwon.

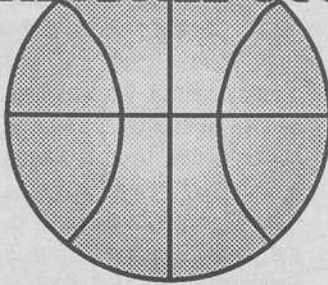

round knockout en route to his third title in three weight classes. In 1990 Chavez met up with, and defeated in a controversial bout, welterweight champ Meldrick Taylor. He later won a controversial draw over Pernell "Sweetpea" Whitaker. Then in 1994, the unthinkable happened. Against Frankie Randall, Chavez was sent to the canvas for the first time in his long career, suffering his first defeat by decision. Three months later, in a rematch, Chavez, 33, regained his title, and has gone on to defend it four times.
