who have enrolled in at least one of our four events or clinics," Lee said. "Each child will receive a free t-shirt, provided by Speedo, the national sponsor of the Inner-City Games."

Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. the Buchanan Natatorium on the campus of UNLV will be the site of the Speedo Swim Clinic, Speedo, as part of its national sponsorship of the Inner-City Games, has hosted clinics in the 10 Inner-City Games cities.

The clinic will feature two top swimmers from Team Speedo. Scheduled to appear are Byron Davies, a 16-time All-American at UCLA and Rowdy Gaines, a 3-time Olympic gold medalist, who was considered the fastest swimmer in the world between 1980 and 1985. Helping coordinate the clinic will be Jim Reitz, the head swim coach at UNLV.

At the clinic, participants will hear speeches from both Speedo swimmers and will be

instructed through fundamental swim stroke techniques, flip-turns and starts. Each participant will also receive Speedo goggles and a swimming cap.

"We couldn't be happier to have swimmers of this caliber host our clinic. These are athletes who have achieved their dreams and goal because of hard work and a relentless commitment. They are great role models for our kids," Lee said.

The Greater Las Vegas Inner-City Games is a festival of sports and educational events for all Las Vegas area children between the ages of seven and 17. These Games give the kids the chance to participate in free beginner clinics and competitions in 12 different sports including flag football, basketball, softball, martial arts, golf, soccer, swimming, track and field, volleyball, tennis and hip-hop.

Additionally, the Games also sponsored a Junior Broadcast program and an art and writing

contest.

Registration for the Games, which ended on May 10 and attracted more than 10,000 area youth, was done through local schools and youth organizations. Clinics and preliminary competitions have been held on Saturdays throughout the Summer.

This Saturday's opening ceremonies will mark the beginning of the Games' final events which will continue until October 10.

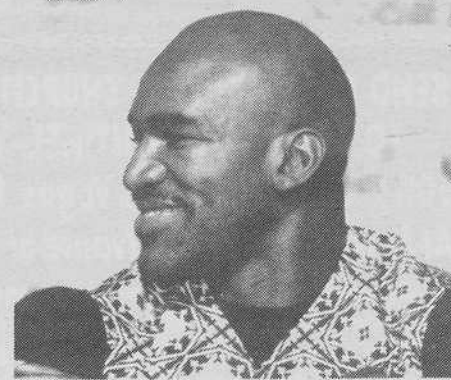

Holyfield cleared to fight Tyson



Former heavyweight champion Evander Holyfield has been cleared by the Nevada Athletic Commission for a Nov. 9 WBA Heavyweight title bout against Mike Tyson, a fight recently announced by promoter Don King at the MGM Grand Garden. After reviewing the results of a series of exhaustive tests done on Holyfield, the Nevada commission unanimously voted to license Holyfield for the fight. The former undisputed champion was determined to be physically fit for competition by the Mayo Clinic, which did tests on Holyfield, including spinal, neurologic and cardiologic examinations.
