Sunday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. the Buchanan Natatorium on the campus of UNLV will be the site of the Speedo Swim Clinic. Speedo, as part of its national sponsorship of the Inner-City Games, has hosted clinics in the 10 Inner-City Games cities.

The clinic will feature two top swimmers from Team Speedo. Scheduled to appear are Byron Davies, a 16-time All-American at UCLA and Rowdy Gaines, a 3-time Olympic gold medalist, who was considered the fasted swimmer in the world between 1980 and 1985. Helping coordinate the clinic will be Jim Reitz, the head swim coach at UNLV.

At the clinic, participants will hear speeches from both Speedo swimmers and will be

instructed through fundamental swim stroke techniques, flipturns and starts. Each participant will also receive Speedo goggles and a swimming cap.

"We couldn't be happier to have swimmers of this caliber host our clinic. These are athletes who have achieved their dreams and goal because of hard work and a relentless commitment. They are great role models for our kids," Lee said.

Additionally, the Games also sponsored a Junior Broadcast program and an art and writing


