



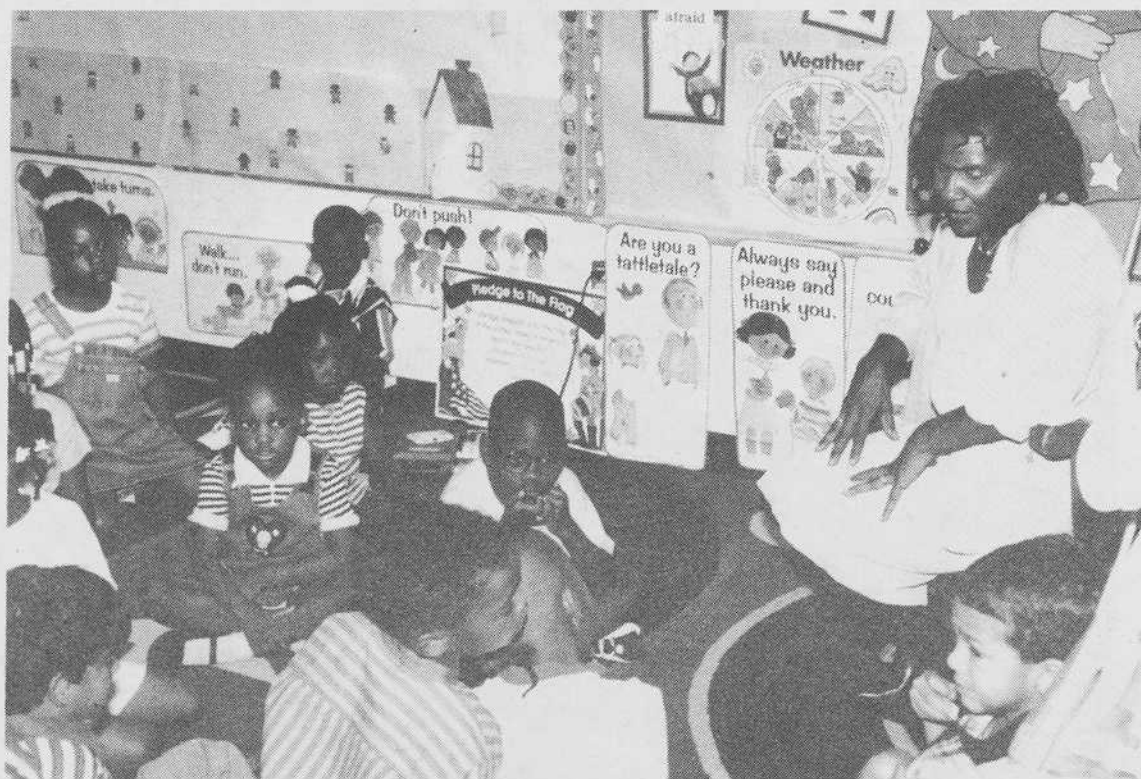
Back to school
