The dangerous part about this is that it gives police carte blanche to do what they want to do. They justify this by thinking that they are making our community a safer place for us to live, work and play," Hampton said.

As difficult as it is for some to accept, the fact is that some who are sworn "to protect and serve" have disdain for citizens. It is also a painful revelation that too many "peace officers" delight in inflicting pain and suffering.

There is no question that individuals are needed to enforce the law. However, those who volunteer for that tough, stressful job should bear in mind that their job is not a license to run roughshod over the rights of those for whom they work.
