of black and white.

That is to say, how, when it's African-Americans being talked or written about, the entire issue is placed inside a "black frame," and, very often, "disconnected" and isolated from being considered part of the American mainstream.

It's not accidental that the "Frontline" program's title was "The Two Nations of Black America" as if blacks live in a separate land, where what they do and think and aspire to has no relationship to what happens in American society — while the news article in *The New York Times* about the white poor in Appalachia was devoid of any reference to race or ethnicity, or, for that matter, a "culture of poverty," at all.

Why is that, particularly when the *Times'* wrenching report implicitly illuminated the parallels that exist between the continued existence of desperate poverty among both poor whites in the depressed, rural areas of Appalachia and the black and Hispanic poor in depressed urban neighborhoods?

No one can honestly examine the problem of poverty in Appalachia and then say that the problem of those African-Americans who are desperately poor is a "black problem" that every American but African-Americans need pay no attention to.
