Africa has also been worst hit by the spreading epidemic of acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS) which, along with civil strife, accounts in part for the high mortality rates.

As of late 1996, nearly 14 million people in sub-Saharan Africa were living with AIDS or the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) responsible for the devastating disease. HIV-infected Africans represent about 63 percent of the world's total, according to the World Health Organization.

The 14 million Africans with AIDS contrasts to the 5.2 million in South and Southeast Asia and the 1.3 million each in Latin America and in Western Europe, North America, Australia and New Zealand.

The average infant mortality rate for Africa is also the highest in the world. During 1990-95, Africa had a rate of 94 deaths per 1,000 live births, and Asia 62 deaths per 1,000 live births. At the other extreme, infant mortality rates were below 10 per 1,000 live births in Northern and Western Europe, North America, Australia and New Zealand.

City and township school officials said the busing program served its purpose.

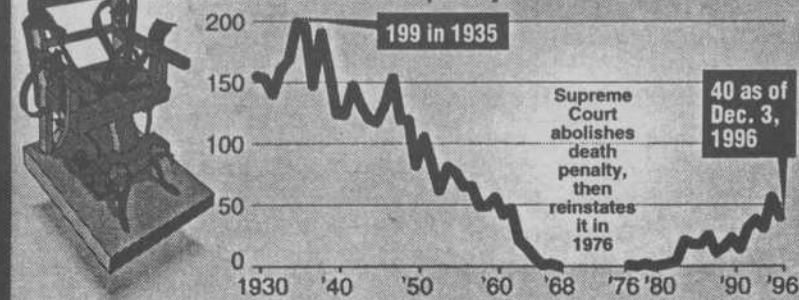
"I would say that Perry Township has changed substantially in terms of acceptance of diversity," said Douglas Williams, township superintendent. "I don't know if that would've happened without court-ordered busing."

John Moss, an attorney who represented Indianapolis' black students in the original case, said he was cautiously pleased.

"We have a plan here that promises realistically to work," Moss said. "But like any plan, it has to be pursued aggressively."
