Why do the races respond differently?

"That's the million-dollar question," Gaasterland, of University Ophthalmic Consultants in Washington, said in an interview. "A study of this design can't answer that, though we're looking into all

of the possibilities we can find. We are looking and we're going to keep on looking because this is important."

The different responses were discovered in the Advanced Glaucoma Intervention Study, an effort to determine the most effective long-term treatment of the disorder. The study looked at 332 black and 249 white patients. Some had glaucoma in one eye, some in both.

The finding comes as doctors research differences in how people respond to drugs. NIH is launching a \$30 million, three-year program to hunt for genetic information that will allow prescriptions to be tailored to an individual, pinpointing differences even more subtle than racial ones.

Mills said another study is under way to see whether the outcome differs for glaucoma patients who use medicine first and later turn to surgery and those who have surgery earlier.
