Evans said he didn't travel outside of the country while in the Navy but upon entering college his penchant for far away places kicked in.

"I traveled a lot in college for enjoyment," he said, and managed to visit Europe. "I traveled on a shoestring."

Through out his medical studies and up to the present he's continued to expand his travels.

"I've traveled all over the world," he said, including every country in Central America, almost every country in South America and the Caribbean, a few countries in Asia and although he's traveled in western Europe he said he hasn't made any visits to Eastern Europe as yet.

He said he often flew to Europe during his college years visiting museums in London and after spending five months in Nigeria, Africa during his stint in medical school, he flew into Amsterdam and visited museums there.

He said although he has 1,000 pieces of African-American art, not all of them are major pieces. Three hundred are from a collection by cartoonist Ollie Harrington who left the country in the Joseph McCarthy era.

Evans said he was instrumental is getting Harrington to return to the United States about five years ago.

The works in his collection have been on display in such places as on the island of Malta in the Mediterranean Sea, the United Nations in Geneva, Switzerland and Pretoria, South Africa. His collection is also available and has been on display in U.S. embassies around the world.

"We can ill-afford to elect someone who will shake our hands before the election but shake our confidence after," she said.
