(Continued from Page 5) Ku Klux Klan by calling the criticism by Will and others "a substitute for their hood." She apologized hours later.

Such incidents make even Moseley-Braun's friends wonder why someone so politically savvy makes seemingly avoidable errors in judgment. "Damned if I know, I never figured it out," said Edith Wilson, who was Moseley-Braun's chief of staff for a year and a half but quit over the Nigeria trip.

Purrington has seen Moseley-Braun's faults, her temper and sometimes erratic work habits, up close. But she says such flaws aren't unusual for a politician, and are irrelevant to Moseley-Braun's job performance.

"We don't elect these officials to take them to dinner, or even to live with them," she said. "If you look at her record, she's where she said she was going to be and has veered very little."

For her part, Moseley-Braun says she has tried to learn from mistakes, but she repeats that no wrongdoing by her - or Matthews -has

ever been substantiated. She also insists that she's been uniquely and unfairly scrutinized.

"I just have to get used to the rules getting changed after the fact," she said. "All I ask is to be treated fairly, by the same standard, the same yardstick."

Like many who know Moseley-Braun, Dora Williams, a member of the senator's 1992 finance committee, now faults Matthews alone. "She was taken in by him and used by him and I don't think she should be blamed for that."

Helene Colvin, Washington's executive assistant and a close friend, suspects Moseley-Braun's insecurities may be at the root of her problems - and of her strengths.

"It makes her real. Anybody in her position runs the risk of believing she's all that. On the other hand, Carol often wants to be all that - to hang with kings and presidents," Colvin said. "What is at risk for her is sliding into the place where that is the driving force."
