One place to start is Washington state, which just passed Initiative 200, another of these noxious antiaffirmative action measures banning consideration of race in admissions, employment and contracting decisions by officials of public institutions and agencies.

We must make it quite clear that these measures don't promote fairness; they promote exclusion.

The precipitous declines this year in the enrollment of black and Hispanic students in seven of the eight universities of the University of California show that unmistakably.

That's why American corporations are pressing ahead with efforts, including affirmative action, to increase diversity.

They know that's where their workforce and their markets are headed.

Unfortunately, Washington state is likely going to repeat California's lesson, and feel the same shock waves: at its 37,500student University of Washington, in Seattle, where today less than 9 percent of the students are black, Hispanic and American Indian; and in its state contracting, where businesses owned by blacks, Hispanics, and white women are going to be shut out of opportunity again.

These are costs the American social fabric - the American "family" - can't afford to bear.
