Lemper who portrays Velma Kelly is certainly not outshined by Rivera and Vereen. Lemper's Velma is sleek, tenacious and world-weary. Her strong singing can be highoctane vaudeville style or bluesy tunes with a delightful touch of irony. She performs some phenomenal, sophisticated dance moves that warranted repeated applause.
