Here is a final thought: What would happen if instead of merely listing where professional basketball players played their college ball, TNT or CBS put up a graphic that listed the academic degrees these players earned upon graduation?

You might think that it doesn't matter by then, but it does. There are many players who become injured or who can't make a career in the NBA, who waste their millions, but who aren't qualified to do a thing beside play basketball. It happens all the time, and demonstrates that our emphasis ought to be on making sure that our students are qualified in every way, and not merely exploited for someone else's benefit.
