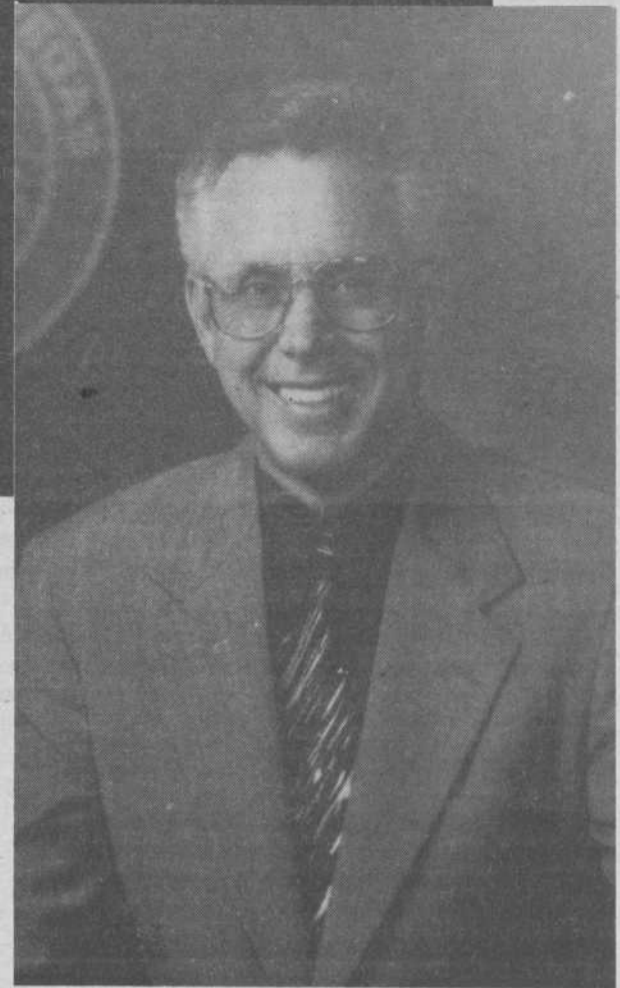


Gary Reese
