months to the general elections in Cote d'Ivoire, five persons, including a pastor, have declared their intention to run for the presidency.

Mel Eg Theodore, a former leading member of the Democratic Party of Cote d'Ivoire, the party overthrown in December, is the latest in the series of entries for the race.

Theodore, 47, head of the Democratic Union of Cote d'Ivoire, is the youngest among the candidates for the country's highest office. He is the current mayor of Cocody, a highbrow residential area in Abidjan.

Earlier candidates include Laurent Gbagbo, leader of the Ivorian Popular Front, the oldest opposition party, and the only person to have challenged late President Felix Houphouet Boigny in an election in 1990.

Alassane Ouattara of the Rally of Republicans is preparing for the race but his candidacy is still being contested because of the eligibility question.

Ouattara, a former prime minister under Boigny, still

ABIDJAN, COTE DIIVOIRE (PANA) - Barely six needs some clarification before his candidature can be valid, as the constitutional provision seems to bar him from the race.

Henri Konan Bedie, the ousted president, had maintained that Ouattara could not stand for the post because he is not a citizen.


Another contestant to the post is Francis Vangah Wodie, former higher education minister under Bedie, who is the flag bearer of the Ivorian Workers' Party.

Robert Gbai Tagro will be running under the ticket of the Republican Party of Cote d'Ivoire.

A pastor of the Methodist church and leader of Ivorian Party for Democracy, Faustin Leka, is fifth candidate.

The former party in power is yet to name its candidate. At its last congress, the party failed to name one, as there was an avalanche of interesteary elections."
