(Continued from Page 11) personal preferences, and even lobbying by citizens and organized groups are likely to influence the final out-

In regard to equal representation, Mississippi's congressional districts each held approximately 514,600 residents when drawn in 1991.

Based on current population estimates, four congressional seats would each be required to represent approximately 704,000 residents.

Under the restrictions of the Voting Rights Act and Justice Department guidelines, it is unlikely that Mississippi will do away with a black majority congressional district - currently embodied in the 2nd District.

However, it is also unlikely that such a district, as one of four total districts, would remain geographically the same as it stands now.

In fact, with the potential loss of one congressional seat, no current congressional district has been or can be singled out for the political ax at this time and no current congressional district will remain unaffected by the loss of a coun-

Each of the remaining four congressional districts will be larger in both geographic size and in population than current districts. Each congressman from Mississippi would represent a far larger group of citizens than they do now. Each congressman would find himself with a constituency that they have never before represented in Wash-

But at the same time, no one knows now which one of the current five congressional districts will be carved up to increase the geographic boundaries or populations of the four that will remain.

If Mississippi does not

meet an accurate and substantially improved population count this year, the political battles will begin for redistricting in 2001.
