NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the CLARK COUNTY HEALTH DISTRICT (CCHD) pursuant to the RYAN WHITE COMPREHENSIVE AIDS RE-SOURCES EMERGENCY (CARE) ACT - TITLE I, is issuing a Request for Proposals to provide HIV/AIDS related services to the Las Vegas, Nevada Eligible Metropolitan Area (EMA). The EMA includes Clark and Nye Counties, Nevada and Mohave County, Arizona. The CCHD will accept sealed proposals from interested, qualified persons, agencies, 501(c)(3) not-for-profits and government entities to provide health care and support services to improve the quality and availability of care for individuals and families affected by HIV/AIDS disease. These services include: Primary Medical Care, Case Management, Housing Assistance, Medication Reimburse-ment, Housing Related Services, Food, Nutrition Supplements, Dental Care, Transportation, Mental Health Treatment/Counseling, Substance Abuse, Treatment/Counseling, Nutritional Counseling, Health Insurance Continuation, Emergency Financial Assistance, Outreach and Case Find-ing, Client Advocacy, Counseling (Other), Health Education and Referral, and Home Health Care.

The project is 100% funded the Catalog of Domestic Affairs Number is 93-914, HIV Emergency Relief Project Grants. Based upon the availability of funds, the anticipated amount available for the above services is \$4,080,000. Contracts will be awarded for a one-year period effective March 1, 2002 through February 28, 2003. CCHD has the discretion to extend the contract period for one year beyond the expiration date of February 28, 2003, based on the continued availability of funding.

Prospective proposers must file with CCHD on or before September 27, 2001 by 4:00 p.m., a letter of intent, an Internal Revenue Service designation of a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization (if applicable), photocopies of all appropriate licenses, including business licenses, certificates, and/or accreditation notices, a copy of proposer's most recently audited financial statement, A-133 audit and management letter and a copy of proposer's Commercial General Liability insurance documentation.
