(Continued from Page 16) involves several NASCAR sponsors and licensees, NASCAR Winston Cup Series teams and tracks, and other related companies. More than 40 interns from across the country have participated, some of whom later accepted full-time positions in the industry.

Urban Youth Racing School (UYRS)—A non-profit organization based in Philadelphia that provides inner-city youths ages eight to 18 with the opportunity to learn about the industry. The 10-week curriculum incorporates hands-on driving, competitive driving techniques and exposure to the different career opportunities available. With a growing number of applicants, UYRS doubled the number of sessions it offers and formed a Junior Staff Committee, composed of previous UYRS students who act as mentors to new students.

NASCAR College Tour presented by the Coca-Cola Co.—The organizations jointly visit HBCUs and Hispanic-serving institutions to build awareness about the related industry and its career opportunities. Students can meet leading industry representatives and learn more about careers from insiders.

NASCAR Technical Institute—Located in Mooresville, N.C., the institute is a partnership between NASCAR and Universal Technical Institute Inc. (UTI) to address the shortage of technicians in the marketplace. The state-of-the-art

facility provides training as an entry-level automotive service technician, with additional training provided for the skills needed to enter the related industry. Students attend 39 weeks of traditional automotive service technology and 18 weeks of NASCAR-specific training. The school attracts a diverse student body and offers a number of diversity scholarship/internship programs.

Even with its laundry list of activities, NASCAR offi-

cialists say they are not stopping there.

"With these and other efforts already in place or being developed, we hope to bring greater diversity—in crew members, drivers, speedway operators, broadcasting, licensing, team ownership and marketing—to our sport," France said.

"We still have a lot of work ahead of us, but are excited about what the future holds."

(Continued from Page 14) arms-producing/exporting countries to exercise the highest degree of responsibility in small arms and light weapons transactions."

He also called for strengthening export controls.

Syrian UN ambassador Mikail Wehbe told The Final Call the only way to stop the proliferation of small arms and mercenaries in West Africa is through regional and sub-regional cooperation. He said the UN General Assembly and the Security Council had adopted many resolutions condemning the use of mercenaries in the internal affairs of states.

"It is simply an issue of supply and demand," Wehbe said. "The demand in West Africa was for its valuable resources."
