help the Iraqi people. Now it's something else. So, you kind of wonder what is it. Why are we over there?"

Others are asking the same question.

"We've not only stretched our active establishment, but we're now calling up the guard and reserve to service under circumstances which they never thought they'd have to serve unless there was something close to a global conflict or an invasion of the United States," explains Togo

West, former Secretary of the Army during the Clinton Administration. "I don't think they ever anticipated being activated in this way and on such a scale and for such a long time. ... It shows what happens if we allow ourselves to be surprised by the magnitude of the task we undertake when we invade or occupy a country."

Even many who opposed the war concede that now that the U.S. is in Iraq, it needs to help stabilize the country.

"Once we get in, we can't

just immediately get out," says Charles Moskos, a military expert at Northwestern

University in Evanston, Ill. Rice, the former State Department official, agrees.

Nevada Department of Transportation Application for Transportation Enhancement Activities Funding

The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) is soliciting applications for transportation enhancement projects for funding for the Federal Fiscal Years 2006-2007. Transportation enhancement activities must be transportation related and are limited to the following activities:

- Provision of facilities for pedestrians and bicycles
- Provision of safety and educational activities for pedestrians and bicyclists
- Acquisition of scenic easements and scenic or historic sites
- Scenic or historic highway programs (including the provision of tourist and welcome center facilities)
- Landscaping and other scenic beautification
- Historic preservation
- Rehabilitation and operation of historic transportation buildings, structures, or facilities (including historic railroad and canals)
- Preservation of abandoned railway corridors (including the conversion and use thereof for pedestrian and bicycle trails)
- Control and removal of outdoor advertising
- Archaeological planning and research
- Environmental mitigation to address water pollution due to highway runoff or reduce vehicle-caused wildlife mortality while maintaining habitat connectivity
- Establishment of transportation museums

This is not a grant program. Project costs will be reimbursed to the project sponsor after they have been incurred. There is a local matching requirement of five percent of the total project costs.

Applications must be submitted by city, municipal, town, county, state or federal agencies, or Indian governments. Private organizations or interest groups are encouraged to apply, but are required to submit their applications through a public entity. Applications must be submitted beginning July 1, 2004. In order to be considered for funding, applications must be received by NDOT by November 1, 2004. Applications received after this date will not be accepted.
