

Sheila Johnson, a former executive of Black Entertainment Television, announced at the MCI Center in Washington on Tuesday that she would become the WNBA's first Black female owner, presiding over the Washington Mystics.

Lincoln Holdings, founded by AOL executive Ted Leonsis, owns the NHL's Washington Capitals and is a 45-percent partner in the NBA's Washington Wizards and MCI Center, which Pollin also owns.

The Mystics said Johnson is believed to be the first Black woman to be a partowner of three professional sports franchises. Johnson's stake in Lincoln Holdings is between 5 and 10 percent.

Leonsis said Johnson will hold the titles of president and managing partner of the Mystics and will represent the team at the board of governors meetings.

NBA Commissioner David Stern and WNBA President Donna Orender joined Johnson, Leonsis and Pollin and his wife, Irene, at the news conference at MCI Center.

Washington International Horse Show, which is held annually at MCI Center.

"I hope that this is a signal that it's about time that a woman, and an African-American woman, is part of this whole scene of sports," said Johnson.

The purchase price for Pollin's share of the Mystics was about \$5.5 million, which would put the franchise's worth at about \$10 million.

The sale is the latest transfer of Pollin's holdings to Leonsis' group. In 1999, Lincoln Holdings bought the Capitals from Pollin, but Leonsis has said that team has consistently lost money. The Mystics, meanwhile, have led the WNBA in attendance five times since beginning play in 1998.
