Dyson covers everything from Cosby's alleged love child, Autumn Jackson, to his son Ennis' murder to his strained relationship with his legitimate daughter Erinn, who has had her well-publicized battles with both drug addiction and sexual assault at the hands of Mike Tyson.

I was surprised to learn that the Cos had been a high school dropout, that he has used the N-word on stage, and that he cared enough about his Jell-o, Kodak and Ford endorsements to refuse to take a DNA test, and to have his out-of-wedlock offspring prosecuted and imprisoned for Blackmail, ostensibly to avoid risking a hit on his image via proof of paternity.

Yes, Dyson does touch on the Black class war and generational divide, but he delineates his position on those conflicts, and rather eloquently, right in the book's Introduction.

Subsequently, each chapter opens with a quote from Cosby's infamous speech which touched off the maelstrom and is followed by well-researched attempts to prove him a hypocrite in relation to his own words by pointing out his moral failings at various stages of his life.
