Of course, baseball was also dropped, hopefully only temporarily, out of the 2012 games, but the women need sports competition, and softball was one of the sports this country was leaning on for its female athletes.

Historically, women's fight for recognition as athletes and not for being the socalled weaker sex, began years ago with Mildred "Babe" Didrikson, who represented the United States in the 1932 Olympics at Los Angeles. Babe won the gold medal in the hurdles but was such a fine athlete she became an outstanding golfer initiating what became the women's golf tour. She struck out Babe Ruth, some historians claim.

The track and field athletes from Tennessee State University also led the attention to female athletes by capturing medals in the 1948 London Olympic Games. Alice Coachman won the high jump that year, and included among the school's outstanding alumnae are Wilma Rudolph, Martha Watson, Wyomia Tyus, Willie White and Edith McGuire.

The U.S. women's basketball team didn't compete in 1980 Olympic Games because of the boycott imposed by President Jimmy Carter on Russia the scene of the games but have won the gold each year in the sport which was added to the Olympics in1976.




