in July and another 211,000 in August. Together that was 77,000 more jobs than previously estimated.

The report also showed that in September: Retailers cut 88,000 jobs. Employment in leisure and hospitality fell by 80,000. Jobs in food services, which includes bars and restaurants, fell by 54,000. Factories eliminated 27,000 jobs, mostly reflecting the impact of a strike at Boeing. On a more positive note, employment in health care grew by 37,000. Construction jobs increased by 23,000 and professional and business services employment went up by 52,000.

Workers' average weekly earnings rose to \$545.27 in September, from \$544.26 in August.

with riot shields and bullet-proof vests, cordoned off the court building and all other cases were delayed until after Zuma's appearance.

He was kept waiting at the door to the packed courtroom while lawyers argued over where he should sit, SAPA reported.

Naidu said he wanted to spare Zuma the "ignominy" of sitting in the box for the accused, but Downer argued

he should be treated like all other defendants.

Magistrate Bilkesh Asmal allowed Zuma to sit with his lawyers.

Zuma has made a number of high-profile appearances in recent days — including a lecture tour in California — to declare his innocence and whip up support for his defense.

The charismatic former anti-apartheid fighter has accused the courts of treating

him unfairly by judging him before giving him a trial.

Shaik was found to have made payments amounting to some \$185,000 to Zuma over a number of years to help fund a lavish lifestyle.


The judge in that case also concluded Zuma was aware of Shaik's efforts to facilitate

a \$77,000 a year payment to the ex-deputy president from French arms trading company Thint Holdings — formerly Thomson CSF — to deflect corruption investigations into a 1999 arms deal with the South African government. Shaik is appealing his conviction.
