Oprah, hero of 'Hotel Rwanda' get awards

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (AP) - Talk show host Oprah Winfrey and Paul Rusesabagina, whose heroism in the face of genocide inspired the movie "Hotel Rwanda," were honored Thursday as recipients of the National Civil Rights Museum's 2005 Freedom Awards.

Winfrey received the National Freedom Award for working to improve the lives of poor children in Africa and helping create a U.S. database of convicted child abusers.

Previous recipients include Coretta Scott King, and former Presidents Bill Clinton and Jimmy Carter.

Speaking to thousands of school children and others gathered at a local church, Winfrey praised Martin Luther King Jr., Rosa Parks, and other civil rights leaders for paving the way for her success.

"Your crown has been paid for," she said.

"Put it on your head and

wear it."

Winfrey, who runs a media company that includes her television show, also urged students to "be the star of your own life" no matter how poor they are or what they do.

Winfrey said she accepted the award and an invitation to come to Memphis because of the chance to meet

Rusesabagina, whom she called one of her heroes.

Rusesabagina received the International Freedom Award, which has previously been given to former South African President Nelson Mandela and rock star Bono.

He is credited with saving the lives of over 1,200 people during the mid-'90s (See Awards, Page 7)
