White. "We should be asking them to pardon us for the way we treated her and others in that period."

The national president of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, Charles Steele, said he would like to see the legislature pardon Parks and others.

Steele, a former member of the Alabama Senate, said he fears that if the arrests remain on the books, someone in the future will look at the records and not understand the moral context of the arrest.

Lillie Mae Bradford, 75, said she was arrested in 1951 after walking to the front of a bus to ask a driver to ask for a different transfer. He said the driver used a racial slur in ordering her to the back. She said that arrest has caused her difficulties over

the years. "It caused me a lot of problems when I tried to get state, federal and city jobs because I had a police record," Bradford said.

The pardons, which would have to be applied for

by those arrested or by a family member, would be available to people who were arrested for violating various segregation-era laws, like the prohibition against entering Whites-only restaurants and other public places.

Hingosso, an official with Nairobi, Kenya-based African Airlines Association. "Many of these flights took place in areas outside of government control, so there's no oversight. We've also tended to notice in the past that many aircraft come from the former USSR."

"We're urging governments to stop getting these old aircraft," said Hingosso, who says the number of passengers is growing at between 6 and 7 percent annually — slightly higher than the global rate.
