Lawsuit targets new touch-voting machines

PITTSBURGH (NNPA) -It did not take Allegheny County Chief Executive Dan Onorato long to attempt to inoculate the county from a recent law suit filed to halt the deployment of new touchscreen voting machines for use in the May 16 primary.

The law suit, filed in federal court April 12, charges the county, the state, and federal officials with jeopardizing citizen's right to vote by forcing them to use machines that have failed in several elections in the last four precinct in the county-and and certified by the Depart-

The lawsuit also charges the machines are discriminatory because voters who cannot use their hands due to an accident or handicap cannot use them or the paper-ballot backup.

Within hours of the filing, Onorato announced the county had negotiated the addition of "sip and puff" technology additions for at least one machine in every precinct. In all, Onorato said 2,628 touch screen voting machines-two for every

a central-count optical scan machine will be in place for the May 16 primary.

The county will have a total of 4,700 machines in place for the Nov. 7 general election.

Onorato also answered charges about the machines' accuracy, saying manufacturer Election Systems & Software has also agreed to upgrade the machines to include voter-verified paper audit trail technology when it is approved by the Pennsylvania General Assembly

ment of State.

"Allegheny County is the only county in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that has negotiated a 'sip and puff' upgrade for its new voting machines," he said.

"The disability community brought this issue to our attention, and I am proud that we have been able to address their concerns. As soon as the Commonwealth certifies the technology, voters in Allegheny County will be able to vote without assistance."

The issue of the machines' reliability, however, remains an issue. Two years after the "hanging chad" nightmare in Florida's 2000 presidential contest, the ES&S machines-which were to fix the problem, failed to work properly. Since then, said lead defendant Celeste Taylor, the machines have also failed in other states.

"The machines elected have failed in elections all over the country-from California to the Carolinas," she said. "In Miami, they turned the 2002 elections into a disaster, where many votersprobably thousands-gave up and went home because they could not vote.'

to train poll workers and voters in the proper use of these machines in the short time remaining before the primary election is also being challenged.

"Voters need a system they can trust," said Taylor. "There is no way that training and voter education can be completed in the five weeks remaining before Election Day. So voters will be denied their right to vote. Even Dan Onorato has admitted this, along with another member of the County Board of Elections John DeFazio—saying it will be a "catastrophe" and "a mess."

As for voter training, Onorato was scheduled to unveil a voter-outreach initiative at 10 a.m. April 19. On the machines' reliability and all other law suit-related mat-

The ability of the county ters, he said it was a state issue and deferred to Commonwealth Secretary Pedro Cortes because the suit would affect 53 out of the commonwealth's 67 counties that purchased similar machines.

On April 11, Cortes' office issued a press release announcing the "Ready. Set. Vote." interactive voter education program designed to give those with Internet access practice with electronic voting through "cultural elections" at ww.votespa.com.

Cortes also said the state will buy print and broadcast advertising to educate voters, and will conduct outreach campaigns into minority communities throughout the


