cantly since the last major expansion more than two decades ago.

The field went from 48 to 64 teams in 1985, then added a 65th team to the field in 2001 when the number of automatic bids went from 30 to 31.

— George Mason, which was one of the last at-large teams to make the field this year, proved parity in college basketball is real. The combination of prominent programs losing underclassmen

at faster rates and scholarship reductions have helped mid-major schools become more competitive. The coaches believe they deserved to be rewarded accordingly.

— Now that the NCAA controls both postseason tournaments, coaches think it's time to include some of the bubble teams that annually complain when they are left out.

Could it happen?
"I don't think the idea of doubling the field is going to happen right now because

there are too many complications to do that," Haney said. "But I think the committee will seriously consider

what the number will be. ...I think if it happens, it will have to happen soon because of the logistical issues."
