lead a campaign to end the AIDS epidemic in Black America.

2) African-Americans should become more knowledgeable about AIDS.

3) African-Americans must get tested and know their HIV status.

4) The federal ban on funding needle exchange programs should be lifted.

5) AIDS prevention ef-

orts should be expanded beyond federal abstinence-only programs.

6) Federal officials should make healthcare more affordable and increase funding for the Ryan White CARE Act.

7) Society should eliminate stigmas that help HIV to spread.

8) African-Americans should organize special programs targeted at key groups afflicted by AIDS, including

Black youth, women, drug users and men who have sex with men.

"We're calling on Black America — from individuals to political, religious and cultural leaders — to commit to taking action against HIV/AIDS by engaging in a coordinated campaign to develop a national commitment to end the AIDS epidemic in our communities by making fighting AIDS a top priority

and setting concrete measurable goals and objectives with real deadlines," Wilson says.

"Black leaders, institutions and cultural icons must identify strategies and activities that match their unique niches and capabilities. We must build a new sense of urgency in Black America, so that no one accepts the idea that the presence of HIV and AIDS is inevitable."
