# L.A. clergy to rebuild ruined churches

LOS ANGELES (NNPA) - As part of a plan under development by former United Nations Ambassador Andrew Young, several key Los Angeles-area ministers have agreed to join a nationwide effort to rebuild churches devastated by Hurricane Katrina.

Still in its preliminary stages, the plan calls for at least 360 churches and synagogues across the United States to collectively send collection proceeds to an "appropriate source" in New Orleans for one month for the purpose of reviving some of the churches and congregations scattered after the August 2005 hurricane.

"We're not trying to say how much, but it would be a Macedonian [large] offering to help those in need. That would give us the capacity to bring back pastors to at least 36 churches," said Young, a New Orleans native, to some 50 clergy representing various denominations who gathered Feb. 9 at West Angeles

Church of God in Christ.

"And we expect those pastors to have a community development coordinator that would, then, as people begin to come back, help them with their insurance claims, damage assessment."

Young said he wants the collective to build a trustworthy network.

"That's all that we're asking today is that you consider your ability to commit your institutions to work with the people in New Orleans," he said.

Ministers who immediately pledged support include: Bishop Johnny J. Young, pastor of Church of God Pentecostal in Inglewood; Rev. Leslie R. White, pastor of Grant AME Church in Watts; and Bishop Charles E. Blake, pastor of West Angeles Church of God in Christ — whose church already relegated \$180,000 to earlier hurricane relief efforts.

"We should have known that this was not enough," Blake said. "This [relief effort] is a long haul and not a

sprint. It's a marathon."

Added New Orleans City Councilwoman Cynthia Williard-Lewis: "Churches are the standard bearer of morality. When there are no churches, there is no soul."

Williard-Lewis represents the 9th Ward, one of the regions hardest hit by Katrina. "You [clergy] are here to help repair the breach," she said. "In mind, body, spirit psy-



chology, finances - every part of your entire being is wounded if you're living in New Orleans - if you're truly living in New Orleans."

A possible alternative to bringing in needed funds, Young said, could be via the Earned Income Tax Credit, which is available to families with at least two children and earnings under \$30,000 a year.

there," he said. "All our churches have people living below the poverty line, who simply by filling out a few papers and answering a few right questions, could pick up about \$4,000 of earned income tax credit — which they've never asked for. They can get it for three years going back."

Young said that most of the church members in New Orleans probably have "\$12,000 waiting for them if somebody helped them to fill out the [tax] papers and ask for it. This is their money. And they have no resources to get it."

John Bryant, CEO of Operation HOPE, said he would assign staff from his organization to work with New Orleans churches as financial counselors. "This is your

"There are monies out money. You worked for it," he said. "And if you don't take it [Earned Income Tax Credit] up, it goes back to the [U.S.] Treasury and disappears.'

"The fact is that time is running out for our people," added Joe Givens, a consultant working with Young. "Eighteen months have gone by now. There are 200,000 people still exiled. It is our belief that unless congregations are able to come back - and stand up full - that they won't come back.

"I don't understand why nothing is happening over there [in New Orleans]," said Givens, also a New Orleans native. "We're not just rebuilding houses, gentleman. We've got to rebuild lives and people."

Taylor says he does not think borrowers of "any race"

"We need to protect consumers in a way that they don't have to be economists" to be successful in owning a home, said Taylor. "Because someone is not financially literate, you shouldn't be able to rob them."

William Spriggs, Chair of Howard University's economics department, says that one of the things resulting in defaults on these loans among Blacks is the effect of adjustable rates on those loans.

"Many think that something like a one percent increase from six to seven is insignificant, but in fact it's a big deal," said Spriggs.

In an attempt to combat harsh outcomes of subprime lending, Freddie Mac, a company that purchases mortgages to support homeownership, has recently announced that the company will refrain from buying subprime mortgages with high likelihood of payment shock and foreclosure.

The company is developing a new model of subprime products that will give more protection, characterized by longer fixed terms and reset periods, according to Sharon McHale, vice president of public relations for Freddie Mac.

Under the company's stricter subprime lending standards, low-documentation underwriting will be limited to ensure that borrowers can afford their homes.

Taylor says in order to limit foreclosures that result from subprime loan defaults, both borrowers and lenders must take responsibility.

Borrowers need to be better educated and informed about their investment, but "[Lenders] ought to be highly honest, highly regulated and highly accountable."
