"I want to maintain the highest GPA," Ledet said. "So when I come home, I make sure to do my schoolwork, take care of responsibilities and maintain a healthy lifestyle."

For Sims and Ayisha Mapp, 18, a Howard freshman political science major, returning to their sleeping quarters at the Salvation

Army each night was an emotional experience. They would hold a debriefing and discuss the day's events.

"To hear about how the boys were so strong was amazing and emotional for all of us," Mapp said. She recounted the story of a 14-

year-old who told of riding out the storm alone and finally having to unhinge the front door of his house to float to safety.

Some students said the trip to New Orleans had changed their lives, some even deciding to change career goals as a result. For Sims, it was a quiet bus ride

back to Washington.

"The boys showed me that your family and your religion is what it all comes down to," she said. "I may not remember all of their names, but I'll never forget their stories."

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PUBLIC NOTICE CITY OF LAS VEGAS PRIVATE ACTIVITY BONDS/ IDR BONDS FY 2007 ALLOCATION

The city of Las Vegas announces the availability of approximately \$47,183,473 of Private Activity Bonds/Industrial Development Revenue Bonds (bond cap/tax exempt financing) to further affordable housing and economic development within its jurisdictional boundaries. This public notice is an invitation to developers to submit an application for affordable multi-family housing development projects and/or economic development projects.

The multi-family housing projects must consist of either 20% of rental units targeted for individuals and families at or below 50% of median income or 40% of rental units targeted for individuals and families at or below 60% of median income. Further details and maps are available with the application package.

Economic development projects shall include any type of economic development activity and manufacturing activities throughout the city of Las Vegas.

The City intends to use one-half of its volume cap for affordable housing development, and one-half for economic development; however, if sufficient applications are not received for economic development, the City's next priority would be to use the total volume cap for multi-family housing.

All applications must be filed with the City's Neighborhood Services Department, accompanied by a non-refundable application fee of \$750.00. The acceptance of an application by the City does not commit the City to issue a resolution transferring volume cap to the project.
