the morning, he suggests eating whole grain since it is more filling. Teens who gradually change their food intake and increase their physical activities will be encouraged by progress. After two to three months, the chil-

dren won't necessarily lose weight but they have maintained their weight, Drucker says. "Once these children realize they can achieve their goals, they are amazed that it didn't take much effort."

African-Americans, who comprise 20 percent of the population, make up 50 percent of the HIV cases in St. Louis. About 65 percent of St. Louis women with HIV are Black, and gay men account for over 70 percent of all cases of HIV/AIDS in the St. Louis area, split almost evenly between Whites and African-Americans.

At the health fair the American Heart Association,

the Center of Medicare and Medicaid Services, Washington University School of Medicine and the Siteman Cancer Center at Barnes Jew-

ish Hospital will provide free health screenings for blood pressure, glucose, cholesterol, sickle cell anemia, bone marrow and prostate cancer.
