Then in 2002 the EEOC settled a major race discrimination lawsuit against The Mirage Hotel and Casino on the Las Vegas Strip for more than \$1 million.

MGM has now chosen its City Center project as the stage to showcase its commitment to diversity. This commitment reaches to the highest levels at MGM. Alexis Herman, former U.S. Secretary of Labor under President Clinton, has been elected to its Board of Directors and serves as chair and CEO of the new ventures.

The City Center will be built with unprecedented participation from Minority, Women and Disadvantaged Business Enterprises.

MGM has raised minority participation within its employee base to more than 50 percent with 12.4 percent being African-American. In purchasing, \$95 million in biddable goods and services were spent with minority enterprises, including 24 percent with women-owned companies and a breakdown of minority-owned compa-

nies as approximately 31 percent Hispanic, 32 percent African-American, 33 percent Asian and 3 percent Native-American-owned enter-

The construction phase of the new project is due to last until 2009 and the City Center is due to open in 2010 at a cost of \$7 billion.

It is designed to change the way people live and work in urban centers. Once completed, the City Center will have more than 2,800 condohotel and condominium units within Project City Center. The Mandarin Oriental, Las Vegas hotel at City Center will include 400 hotel suites as well as more than 200 condominium units designed to appeal to an international demographic.

Also, two leaning 400unit condo towers, located in the middle of the City Center site and above several floors of retail space, are designed for a younger demographic who desire living in an urban environment. City Center will also include a 4,000-room resort hotel designed by world renowned architect Cesar Pelli, and MGM Mirage, one of the more than 500,000 square feet of retail space.

The other condo buildings include a condo-hotel with about 300 apartments and a bigger tower with about 1,500 condo-hotel units, all located within a 76-acre spot of land in Downtown. Prime real estate includes the nowimploded Boardwalk Hotel and Casino and adjoining land between the Bellagio and the Monte Carlo.
