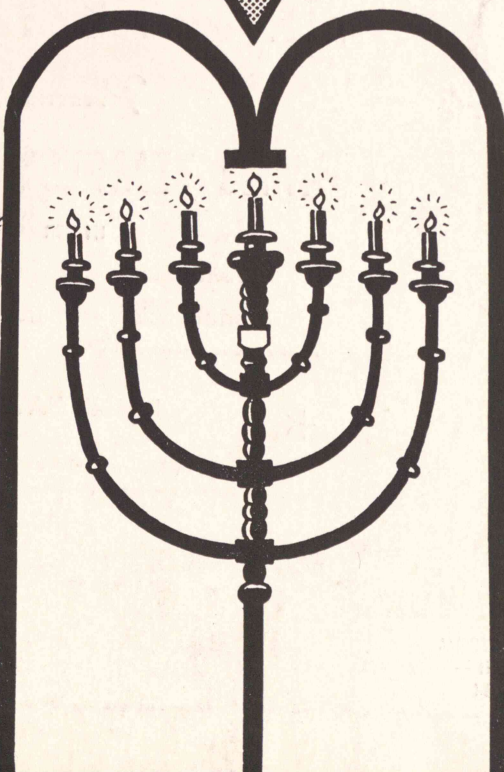

OBSERVATIONS

THE MEADOWS

IT IS GENERALLY accepted
as true that Las Vegas re-
ceived its name from Father
Garces, one of the first Spanish ex-
plorers in 1776.

In that year, Father Escalante, in
Santa Fe, New Mexico, started west
hoping to find the great river, San
Buena Ventura, which he thought
flowed from the Rocky Mountains di-
rectly west into the Bay of San Fran-
cisco. Needless to say he did not find
it, because no such river existed.

So he returned to Santa Fe via a
more southerly route: South from
about where Cedar City now stands,
and followed the Rio Virgin to the
Colorado River and thence east to

Santa Fe. He was probably the first
white man to ever see the Grand
Canyon.

Father Garces led a party, assem-
bled from where he had founded a
mission in California, toward the east,
seeking a shorter route to the mission
at Santa Fe. He came upon a great
river, the Rio Colorado, which, in-
stead of flowing directly west to the
Pacific, had been turned south by
intervening mountain ranges and
emptied into the Gulf of California.

The party established a station near
the mouth of the Colorado River and
then Father Garces decided to do
some exploring on his own.

His party was friendly with the

ICAME upon another remarkable phase of Americana last Monday night and that was how one particular minority nationality group in this country is educating their youngsters so as to keep alive all of the culture and charm that they had known and loved in their homeland before migrating to this country as "newcomers." I attended the ALL UNIVERSITY TAMBURITZAN concert and program at the Milaca High School Auditorium and when I arrived I found every one of the 800 seats occupied with the curtain just going up.

On stage were seventeen of the most handsome and vivacious college youngsters I have seen in many a year. Matt L. Gouze, who hails from the Iron Mining region of Northern Minnesota, and who, incidentally, is a former athlete and graduate of my alma mater, St. Thomas College in St. Paul, directs and trains this group. All the boys were dressed in colorful Serbian costumes of wide, full pantaloons in white silk, vests of blue embroidered with flowers, knee-length boots with turned-up toes and all had beautiful dark eyes and shocks of black curly hair. The girls were in native Yugoslavian costumes of full-skirted peasant dress, vests and little caps, and completed a picture on the stage like some of the creations I have seen at the Folies Bergere in Paris when that group re-enacted framed pictures of real life goings-on.

The Croation Board of Trade sponsors this group and gives each one a scholarship to any University or college near, or in Pittsburg. And of course, while attending college, these youngsters play in the ALL UNIVERSITY TAMBURITZANS.

Al Kurre, a good looking young teacher in the Milaca school system,

is a friend of the director and he induced them to stop off in this small town and perform. The cast got Al to go on stage and dance with the gals and now he certainly will be the most popular teacher in that town for a long time to come. Al took me back stage after the concert ended to meet the cast.

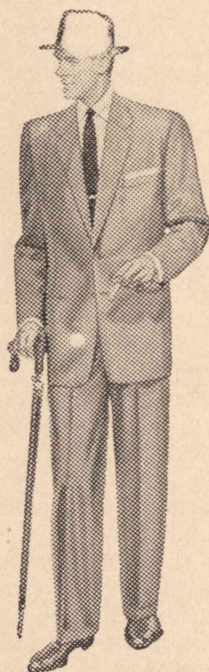
Father Richard John of St. Mary's Church in Milaca had the Father Hennepin (discoverer of Minnesota) Men's Group sponsor the concert and afterwards this group held a reception and party for the cast in the church parlors. Incidentally, St. Mary's was just dedicated and is so modernistic that Father told me he had to put up a reading "THIS IS NO MOTEL", in order to keep tourists from asking for rooms there. George Zatezall of Weirton, West Virginia, is a freshman at Pittsburgh University and he insisted that I go to the party with them. He saw to it that I never missed a dance with one of the gals in the cast, and I was taught some Tyrolean and Serbian dances and had more fun than I have had in a long time. George is a curly, black-haired youngster, who dances, sings and plays like a seasoned performer and has eyes that stand out while on stage as if they were looking right through you. I told him they were as striking and dramatic in appearance as those of both Fulton Sheehan and His Holiness Pope Pius XII. (And they truly are!) Tall, dark and handsome young Dan Radakovich who hails from Evelth, Minnesota, stole the show when introduced as the only Minnesotan in the cast. He plays bass and also attends Pittsburgh University. Del Kacher of Hammond, Indiana was another youth I would like to know better. He plays the

LOUIE has pared down to thirty-five pounds lighter than when he last appeared here, and KEELY now tips the scales at a feathery 112! Both of them went on a diet about four months ago, and ever since the pounds have just been fading away. . . .

In the same Lounge the famous dancing drummer, NORMAN BROWN, continues to beat out rhythm galore with his educated

drums. For sheer brilliance in "drumnastics" on a wide variety of musical styles none could possibly top this attention getting combo headed by NORMAN, a masterful exponent of syncopation. . . . 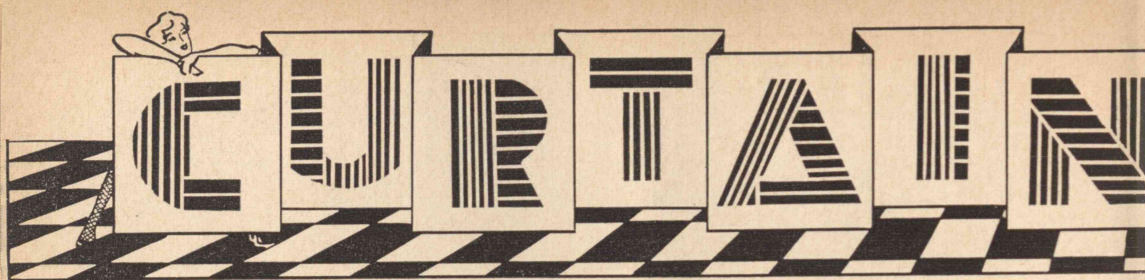

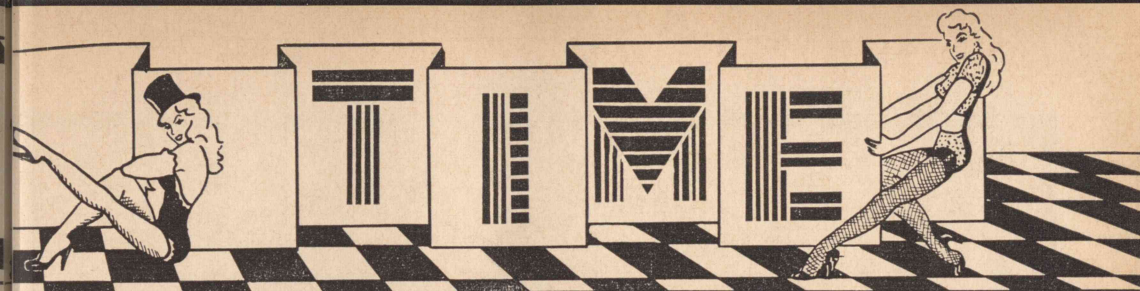

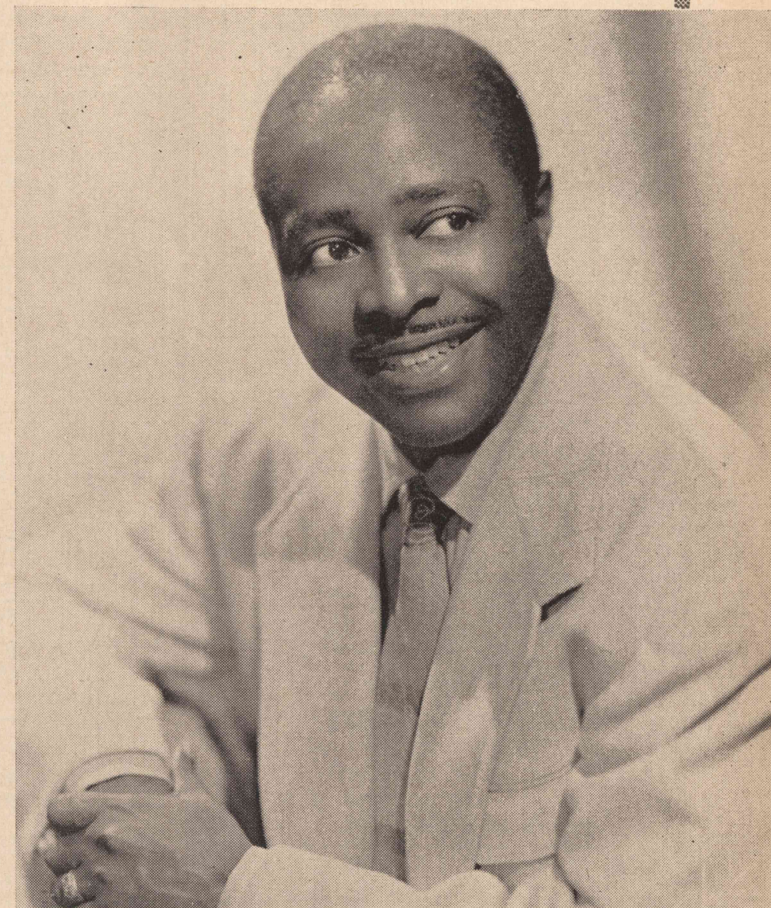

Indians and taught them how to fashion floating logs into boats. Then he taught them how to make cables and ropes out of fibres. Thus he ingeniously created both boats and a means of propulsion, which enabled the Indians, walking along the bank of the river, to tow their boats up the river as far as the mouth of El Dorado

Canyon. It was impossible, however, to tow the boat through the swirling rapids in Black Canyon and Father Garces, with his party, set up camp and did a little more exploring in that vicinity. One of these trips was to the northwest where upon coming over the crest of a hill, Father Garces beheld the miracle of green trees and long stretches of green grass. He at once crossed himself piously, stretched forth his hand and exclaimed, "Dios, Gracias, Las Vegas!" Translated this means, "Thank God, The Meadows!" "Vegas" is a Spanish word meaning meadows or fertile plains. That, I think, is the real story of how our Fabulous City of Las Vegas received its name.

Only those who saw this place more than fifty years ago, when the waters from the great springs flowed down Las Vegas Creek and spread themselves over hundreds of acres of green meadows, can appreciate what this name really meant.

To those of you who would like to do a bit of interesting research for

yourselves, I recommend that you read a little volume entitled "Romance of the Colorado" by Frederick Dellenbaugh, who was a guest at the old ranch when the Gass family lived there. I read the volume long ago but believe it is still to be found in some libraries. This book relates an interesting story about how Father Garces and everyone in his party was brutally murdered by his Indian "Friends." It is well worth reading if you can locate it.

Much later, early in 1931 to be exact, dawn broke on a new era in Las Vegas — the era in which great hotels, night clubs and casinos became the dominant factor in the growth of our town. Gambling had been legalized and some short steps taken toward making it honest as well as legitimate.

Three young fellows appeared on the streets of Las Vegas and said they were going to build one of the finest night clubs and casinos in the country here. The three enterprising young chaps were Tony, Frank and Louis Comero. They bought a piece of land on the south side of what is now Charleston Boulevard, about three-eighths of a mile east of where it crosses Fremont and set to work with vigor.

Soon the framework of quite a pretentious structure arose and we were quite pleased and excited by its extravagance. The opening was set for May 2, 1931, and invitations were sent to everybody in town and they all came! There was a rather large dining room with a large casino opening onto the wide veranda. The dining room was provided with stage scenery and removable seats so that the floor could be used for dancing. In the casino there were whirling roulette wheels and the other usual games. There was a most beautiful "Gold Room" which was used often for private social affairs plus several other rooms for the use of card parties.

It seemed to us like a perfect layout and everyone was happy to have such wonderful accommodations provided for social gatherings.

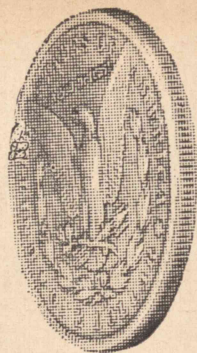
The opening was given a full page spread in the "Las Vegas Age" — a very unusual thing for those days — and the guests list contained many of the old-time residents who are still living here: Messers and Mesdames A. W. Ham, C. S. Wengert, Ryland Taylor, James Cashman, Charles Dimock, J. M. Heaton, Will Beckley, R. B. Griffith, S. J. Lawson, A. E. Cahlan, C. D. Breeze, W. N. Schuyler, C. C. Boyer and Charles P. Squires plus countless others, some who have moved to other places and others who have passed away.

For many months The Meadows was the favorite place for all the social gatherings in Las Vegas and we were all very proud to show this beautiful Night Club to our out-of-town friends. We felt that we could look into the future toward the time when The Meadows, and other similar spots, would be the dominant factor in drawing tourists to Las Vegas. We even had the nerve to hope that some day we might vie with Reno in tourist travel!

All dreams have a way of fading. One day there was an alarm of fire at The Meadows, and our very efficient volunteer fire department sped out Fremont Street to Charleston, thence east toward The Meadows where clouds of smoke could be seen billowing into the air. Then, at the city limits, two or three blocks from The Meadows, they stopped and watched part of the night club burn to the ground.

The Comeros were very properly furious and when the fireboys, quite disheartened, explained the City Commission had recently issued an order forbidding the fire department from taking the fire truck outside the city, it did not remedy matters. The Meadows, on which we had placed such high hopes, was closed, never to open again for business. It was a staggering blow for poor little Las Vegas.

Other quite pretentious places were built, with the expectation that the thousands of men employed building Hoover Dam might make them pros-



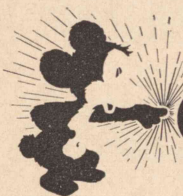

per. There was the Colony Club, corner of Fremont and Charleston; the Dunes close by and other quite elaborate places which (we soon learned) the dam workers considered too high-toned. They all sank in obscurity and as I remember, the Pair-O-Dice — changed later into the 91 Club and built, I think, by Guy McAfee — is still retained as part of the casino and bar of the Last Frontier.

I am moved to write of The Meadows by the thought of the great Hotel Stardust, standing almost, but not quite, completed.

More than a year ago, after the death of its promoter, Tony Cornero, it experienced serious financial troubles.

The lack of activity there is particularly noticeable just now when the thousand rooms of the Stardust are so greatly needed to accommodate the growing flood of tourist visitors.

After the death of Tony, his brother, Louis Cornero, was prevailed upon to try and straighten out the tangled

threads of the Stardust's affairs, but to no avail.

But there is no doubt that funds will be found to complete the Stardust and the sooner the better for Las Vegas.

Shirado, the famed Japanese Sage, wrote: "When Men fly up in the sky, Japan will make a mistake and attack the Eagle." This was written in 1607 and at that time meant nothing. But in 1941, "when men fly up in the sky" Japan did make a mistake and attacked the Eagle (symbol of the United States) — exactly 334 years later! Shirado also wrote: "Men can exchange thoughts through the thin air, and converse satisfactorily" (radio, telephone, cable; "Madness can be controlled by a wanton plant" (the new tranquilizers); "Japan will have the rising sun as a symbol" (this was not adapted to the flag until 1801) and that "Man-made silk will endanger the food Japan eats!" This amazing prediction took over 300 years to come about, for rayon, synthetics and dacron could have easily wrecked the Japanese economy! Shirado also predicted a federated nations of the world! How correct was he?

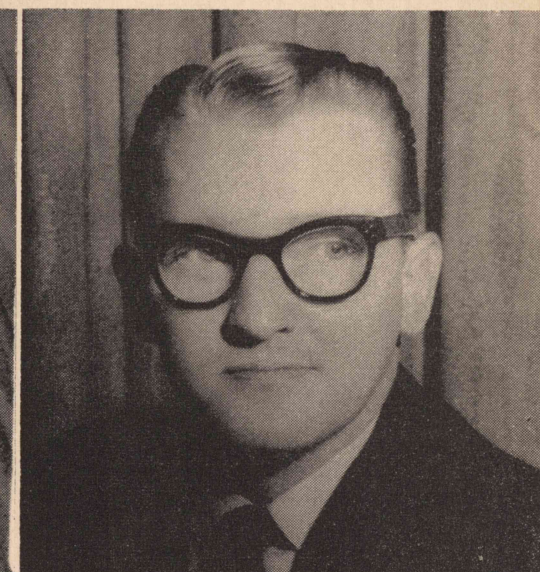

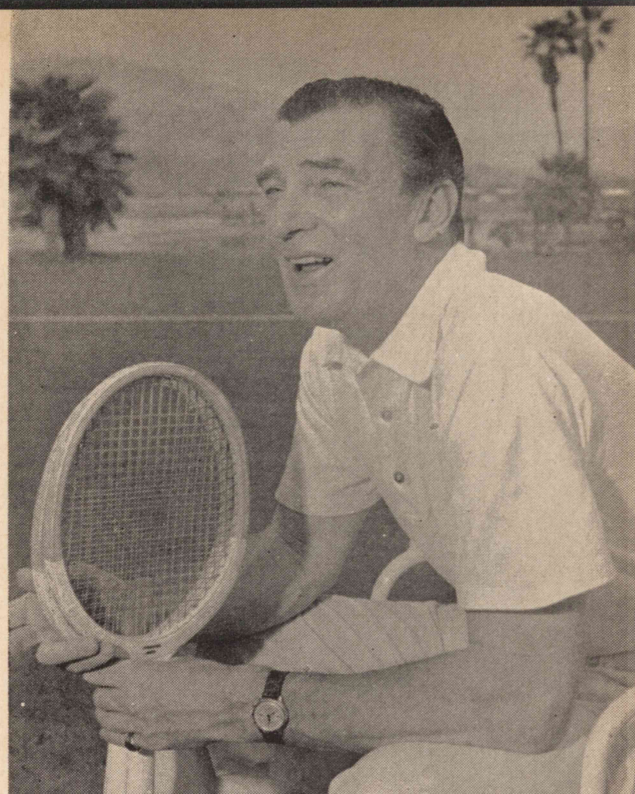

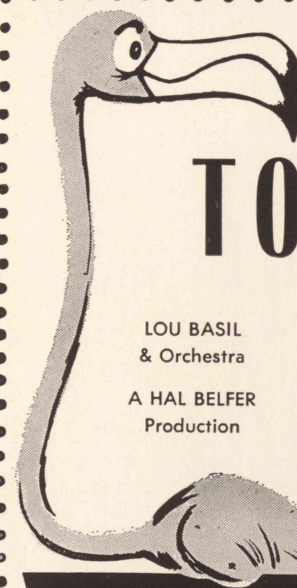
