

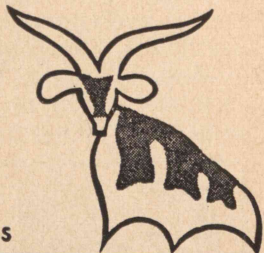

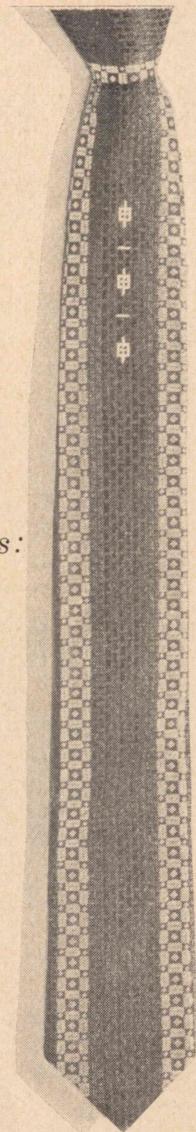

SOME eight to nine years ago
when we first settled in this
thriving Desert Community,
Las Vegas was already well on its
way toward establishing itself as the
"Entertainment Capital of the World."
While the title is at best a nebulous
one that surely would arouse a nega-
tive response in New York, Paris, Lon-
don or neighboring Hollywood, it
sticks, and most of us who live here
truly believe it to be so. By the same
token Fabulous Las Vegas, city of a
constant parade of the biggest names
in showbusiness, has been primarily
a "showtown" and music, the back-
bone of showbusiness, has consistant-
ly occupied a secondary roll. The
advent of big names and acts in the
Lounges changed this somewhat
through the years, but never came on
quite strong enough — until the pres-
ent moment — to compete on any-
where near equal terms. However,
with names like HARRY JAMES,

are getting treated to what's best in

Opening night we were able to

southland. . . . Later on in the eve-
ning found us in the Showcase
Lounge of HOTEL TROPICANA
soaking up the notes being manu-
factured by RAY ANTHONY. This
unit sounded absolutely sensational in
every department, but we'd like to
pass on special bows for the standout
hornwork of CARL FONTANA, one
of the greatest trombones going to-
day. . . . When THE MARY KAYE
TRIO bow out of the Casbar Theatre
of HOTEL SAHARA December 8th,
they'll turn the headlining reins over
