



RUNNING true to form last Sunday we pulled one of our usual brilliant stunts and locked the house key inside. Naturally inside the house was the nitebook full of items for this weekly column. . . . Since everyone is vacationing and will be gone for two more weeks it's liable to get a little annoying if we can't find a way in. . . .

Several days ago we were invited to attend the kickoff luncheon for the 1960 STARDUST Invitational Basketball Tournament. Servicing on the Board of Directors are THOMAS McDONNELL, Chairman, and MILTON JAFFEE of the STARDUST; JOHN CAHLAN and JOHN ROMERO, LAS VEGAS REVIEW-JOURNAL; JAMES DEITCH, Las Vegas News Bureau; HOWARD CAPPS, Head Pro at the DESERT INN COUNTRY CLUB and WENDELL BUNKER, former City Commissioner and prominent Realtor. All proceeds from the event will be channeled to the UNITED FUND of LAS VEGAS. The new tournament sponsors have provided an 18,000 dollar basketball floor and scoreboards for the Convention Center, a 9,000 seat structure which will rank among the top basketball pavilions in the nation.

There are still several days remaining before the June 30th deadline for entries in the "Name Downtown" contest and while entries containing a very imaginative selection have been pouring in the winner may still be on the tip of someone's tongue. Remember, there is no age limit, entry blanks are not required, you may submit as many entries as you wish and the top prize is 500 dollars in cash. 



THE HOTEL DULUTH in Minnesota, overlooking the largest lake in the world, Lake Superior, is one of my favorite hotels on this continent. Clem R. Schiek is the manager and the hotel is owned by the Schroeder chain that also owns Hotel Wausau in Wausau, Wisconsin; Hotel Northland in Green Bay; Hotel Retlaw in Fondulac; Hotel Loraine, Madison; Hotel Schroeder, Milwaukee; Hotel Astor, also in Milwaukee, and the Hotel Vincent in Benton Harbor, Michigan. These are all very well run hotels and I recommend them highly.

One of my very best friends, Bill Wolf, used to manage the Duluth Hotel and now is general manager of HOTEL ST. PAUL, in our capital city. By the way, he and Addie and their three lovely children, Bill Jr., John and Liz, spent Memorial Day with me here at the lake. Be sure and ask for a room on the lake side at the DULUTH where you will be able to watch all the boats going and coming and you can see for miles. In fact, SUPERIOR is so big you cannot see across it and it looks exactly like an ocean.

The BLACK BEAR LOUNGE here is world-famous; it is where the bear actually broke the plate glass window to get in a few years back and is now mounted back of the bar. Excellent food in the dining room and conventions galore meet at this fine hotel.

I am told by those in the know that there are really only two good eating places in Duluth, the DULUTH HOTEL and, of course, the FLAME.

Be sure not to miss the FLAME, one of America's most famous restaurants. Down on the waterfront, it is only a block from the aerial bridge, and the big ships glide past your plate glass window and table within a couple of hundred feet of you. The food is excellent and the decor outstanding. With music and entertainment it stays open for lunches, dinners and late suppers. My friend, Jim Oreck, owns it and he is aided by Hub Gagne now serving as manager. Jim used to own, in fact he built, the famous FLAME in Phoenix that I helped cut the ribbon for many years ago, but has returned to Duluth to run this FLAME exclusively. I would rate the FLAME in the top fifteen restaurants in the country — don't miss it.

For afternoon tea or a light lunch or coffee, the PLAZA out on East Superior Street (the longest street in the world) is tops. Met an old friend there, Mrs. J. R. Kuth, whose late husband was one of the top doctors in Duluth and who is the mother of three of my very best friends, Anne, now Mrs. Howard Hoehne of Billings, Montana, Eddie, an engineer with American Iron and Fence Company of Joliet, Illinois, and Bob, one of Duluth's most outstanding young men
