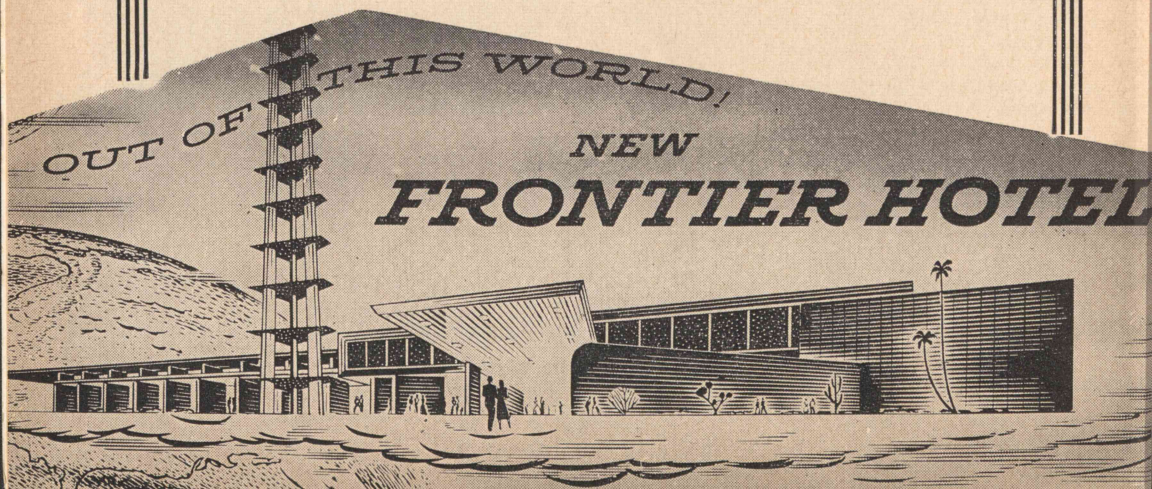

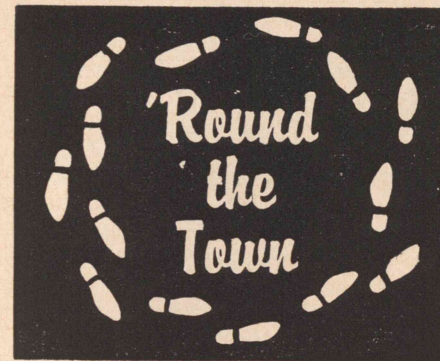

marching units performing beforehand. The name of the king or his identity has been a guarded secret until the time he is presented to his subjects at the auditorium. On Saturday afternoon is held the grand parade which lasts two and a half hours and ends up inside the huge municipal auditorium. This year the theme was taken from Disneyland characters. Tom Tryon, Texas Slaughter, marshalled the parade. On Tuesday evening was the grandest event of all — the Coronation of the queen. This is one of the most dignified and beautiful affairs I have ever seen. All the visiting queens are escorted in by ROTC officers from the Univ. of Minnesota, the King and his guards and retinue arrive and are enthroned, and then the dozens of Princesses arrive with their boy friends who are resplendent in white ties and tails and the girls who are all candidates for next year's queen, are dressed in full floor-length gowns. They march in after being heralded by trumpeters, and to the tune of Wunderbar played by a huge symphony orchestra. The Modernaires sang several numbers, and the entire cast of Matt Gouze's Tamburitzans performed several ballet numbers, instrumental and solos, and then came the moment all had been waiting for when the King commanded that the princesses march back on the huge floor and he descended from his throne, or rather had his Prime Minister do so, and pick his queen to reign with him for the coming year. This was a tense moment for all these pretty gals. He picked Miss Lux from Remington Rand Univac, and I think everyone had already picked her out as the one to be chosen before the King did. After proper crowning ceremonies the King commanded all his princesses and their escorts to follow him in a grand march around the auditorium floor, much to the delight of the 9,000 spectators and when they had finished marching all swung into a GREAT WALTZ, lights were dimmed, a shining ball threw mirrored lights all over
