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





Don in weeks was killed ferrying an army bomber; the \$50,000 statue the Browns erected for their beloved eldest at Forest Lawn; Joe E. going on the battle-fronts to entertain our men; Joe E. engaging in actual combat and receiving heroes medals; his always-ready smile to make people happy; his trophy room stacked to the ceiling with the world's appreciation for his endless giving of self and his talent; the formal wedding with Kathryn lovely in her white satin gown and veil and Joe E. in a cutaway, striped pants and white tie, as the bridal couple renewed their vows on their 25th anniversary. "We were two poor kids who got married at City Hall, and now I owe this, Kathryn's dream wedding, to her"; Joe E. acting as my father to give the bride away at my own wedding; Kathryn lending me her little pearl covered bible - to hold for something old; Joe E. and Kathryn sending a special plane of flowers from Baldoccio in San Francisco for my wedding; The Browns always did everything so magnificently.

pay their respects to this all American idol. Ba" parks all over the world were named in his honor. Son Joe L. became, to his father's delight, a shining light in the baseball world. Joe E. was one of the world's best dressed men - dapper and groomed to perfection and on several International lists; His adopted son, then sports announcer Mike Frankovitch, becoming one of Hollywood's most successful producers added to Joe E.'s pride; the birthday party I gave for Joe E. six years ago, and his brilliant wit and the good time he had at my home with the twenty four guests who included Mayor Sam Yorty and other notables. Joe E. was saddened because Mike and Binnie and Kathryn couldn't make it. "I had to come in a taxi, because I couldn't find my car keys," he said. From seven until two in the morning Joe E. was laughing and having such a good time. "The best time I've had in years." Looking back seven people at my party for Joe E. have passed on - Joe E., Martin Von Dehn, Mrs. Martin Von Dehn, Jayne Mansfield, Patti Moore, Ida Mayer Cummings and Victor Huston. "Life is much shorter than we think," Joe E. had said that night. Numerous telephone calls, the pain in his back which had been broken when he was a boy circus athlete.

All of those wonderful memories of recall he'd left to me and thousands more to thousands of people. JERRY LEWIS is a very funny man. In Europe he's been described as the successor to Charlie Chaplin. In America most of the movies he makes are boxoffice successes.

Few fans realize just how serious he can be and just how close to his heart is **Muscular Dystrophy**.

When the famed comedian is not teaching a filmmaking class at the **University of Southern California**, working on a film or appearing on stage, he always makes time available for **Muscular Dystrophy** without asking anyone for one cent. In fact it costs him money out of his own pocket.

The last five months he's been traveling around the country working on the **Muscular Dystrophy Labor Day Telethon** to be telecast nationally. This will originate from **Del Webb's Hotel Sahara**, which is donating all its public facilities and the service of its staff to the gala holiday weekend event. Television cameras will shift from city to city.

"I realize **Lewis** spends a lot of time on dystrophy," a volunteer noted after attending a local meeting with the comic. But seeing him gave me insight to how devoted he is—no one knows how much he really does."

Lewis has met with many station managers and hosts for the 150 TV stations carrying this year's telethon. Volunteers have been attending workshops to help familiarize them with MD and telethons.

There is no pay for **Lewis** as he spends hours meeting people and cutting promotions. It is incredible.

Lewis began doing the yearly telethon in 1965. Since then it's grown from a local

New York show to a national telethon. Local dignitaries, entertainers and representatives of organizations will appear on the telethon.

"During the 20 hours of the telethon 75 children will die from M.D. and that's what keeps me going," said **Lewis**. This is one man who doesn't dwell on his **Muscular Dystrophy** activities.

All of his fans consider him a clown and a clown he is. He makes people laugh but he also faces the very real, sad facts of life very personally.

Do not forget the date and pledge what you can. It's for a great cause.

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The Hollywood Chef



In the hey-day of Hollywood, all the major studios had commissaries that were really very fine. As time moved on, and less and less was happening in Hollywood, the studios began closing down their food operations.

Today, with only six major movie studio lots in operation, there is one that has kept its food division open throughout the years, namely, the **Walt Disney Studios** in Burbank, California. I have had the fortune of eating there on numerous occasions during the years. **The Cafe** is always good, but my favorite is the **Coral Room**. The continental menu is always well balanced and superb in service as well as quality. After your entree has been served by a courteous waitress and you are well into the main course, a very nice, soft-spoken gentleman comes out of the kitchen and asks if you are happy with your choice. This is the Executive Chef-Manager of food, **Henry Cohen**.

Henry was educated in his native Holland, and was an apprentice chef at the age of fourteen in one of the largest hotels in the Hague. He spent ten years on the **Holland-American Line** and the **Holland-Australia Line**, before he decided to settle in Los Angeles as banquet chef of the **Beverly Hills Hilton Hotel**. With the help of two chefs, one cook's helper and 1 pantry chef he serves 600 lunches on an average day in the **Cafe**, which serves cafeteria style and 30 to 50 in the **Coral Room**, that caters to the stars are working on the lot, as well as studio executives and visiting dignitaries and newspaper reporters.

One of the most popular dishes **Henry** serves is **Filet of Sole, Veronique**:
6 fillets of Sole
1 egg

1 cup flour
3 tbl. butter 2 tbl. Chablis Wine
1tbl. seedless grapes
salt to taste

Wash fillets in ice cold water. Dry on paper towel. Lightly salt the flour. Dip fish in flour on both sides. Dip fish in beaten egg and dust again in flour. Shake excess flour off fillets. Heat butter in frying pan and saute fish in butter until brown on both sides. Place fish on heated serving plates. Add wine and grapes to the hot skillet. Reduce liquid to 1/3 of amount and pour over the fish, serve at once. Serves two.

The day I was in the **Coral Room** at the **Disney Studio**, I was joined by **Ben Hartigan**, my good friend of many years, one of the top publicists at the Burbank, California lot. **Calvin Bartlett**, the actor, was at our table. He told of his recent assignment on ABC-TV's "Mod Squad." We had a marvelous lunch, and as we ordered the dessert course and coffee, **Henry Cohen** joined us to discuss our favorite subject, food. He believes, "That the American public is now becoming more aware of good quality food." He

MEANDERINGS ABOUT MAILER'S 'MARILYN': To set the records straight early we never succumbed to **Miss Monroe's** looks, lure or acting. We

accepted her as a pleasant enough screen contrivance. But then our track record of responding to super sirens of the screen is an object of discussion. **Grable, Turner, Taylor** and even in our young days, **Harlow** - all did nothing for this male film watcher. Who did he like, you question? What cinema lasses captivated him lo these past few decades? Are you ready? **Hayworth, Gardner, Fleming, Dahl**, yes even way back, **Ilona Massey**. As for **Mailer**, there is admiration. **Norman** is a heavy writer, he pounds his thoughts across. Often as you read him some of his personal eruptions spill over the pages. Somehow **Mailer's** opinions come through as controlled violence. His style is masculine nearly to a fault, but when you reflect his prodigious talent and accelerated drive that propel him on and on, whereby a book can be turned out in weeks not months, you come away with respect for the guy. He may be the best since **Hemingway**. In some areas he's better than **Ernest** the enigma. What we have at hand is "**Marilyn**," a biography of **M.M.** To publisher, **Grosset & Dunlap's** credit is the striking cover, the exceptional promotion and distribution and a handsomely bound book. The contents are up for argument. As an assortment of pictures, no one will quarrel. It is a beautiful album. In reviewing a life and revealing the past, **Mailer** relied on personal passion, incomplete interviews, much heresay and reams of conjecture. Do we have a simple girl from a broken home who went mad after being injected with Hollywood's opiates? Or are we recalling the times of a complex female who was a



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added, "This country has everything going for it to become the best culinary country in the world." He further says, "If you go out to eat somewhere you expect good quality and good service. Some Restaurants try to fool the public in order to make a buck, but they don't last long."

It is most unusual for three people to order the same salad dressing. This lunch time we all had the Green Goddess Dressing. I immediately knew on tasting it, this was one recipe **Henry** had to share with you.

Green Goddess Dressing

2 cloves garlic, minced
2 teaspoons salt
1/2 tsp. white pepper
1 1/2 tsp. dry mustard
1 tbs. Worcester sauce
1/2 cup anchovy paste
3/4 cup tarragon wine vinegar
3/4 cup chopped parsley
1 qt. mayonnaise
2 cups sour cream
3 drops green food coloring

Combine the first seven ingredients. Gradually add in the chives, parsley, and mayonnaise. Blend well. Fold in the sour cream. Add the green food coloring, if desired. Refrigerate for two hours to blend the flavors. Serve on your favorite salad greens or seafood salad. This recipe yields 1 3/4 quarts.

Henry Cohen is a very interesting fellow, whose career has taken many turns in the food business. He helped set up the food services at the **University of California** at Santa Barbara, California. He also cooked for Presidents **Truman** and **Eisenhower** when he was the banquet chef at the **Beverly Hilton Hotel**. One of the most popular desserts at the **Disney Studios** is **Henry's Super Cheese Pie**.

Henry's Super Cheese Pie

1 unbaked 8-in. graham cracker crust
1 1/2 8-oz. packages soft cream cheese
2 eggs
1/4 cup granulated sugar
1/2 tsp. vanilla extract
1 cup commercial sour cream

Heat oven to 350 degrees. With an electric mixer at high speed, or a hand beater beat cream cheese, eggs, sugar and vanilla until smooth and creamy. Turn into crumb crust. Bake 35 minutes. Top with reserved crumbs. Spread sour cream on top. Cool. Serve as is or top each wedge with fresh sliced or frozen strawberries. Fresh, canned or frozen sliced peaches are also good. Use the basic Graham Cracker Crust as found on a box of Graham Crackers.

If you never get a chance to tour the **Walt Disney Studios** in Burbank, California, you now have some of **Henry Cohen's** secret recipes. You too can enjoy the same good food as did **Mary Poppina** and **Mickey Mouse**.

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


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
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
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
