## Biographical Note

---

Assemblywoman Sandra (Sandi) Krenzer was born in Pasadena, California, in 1948. She served as a Democrat in the Nevada State Assembly in the 1991, 1995, and 1997 regular sessions. Krenzer served on many boards, including the Private Industry Council and Literacy Council. She also belonged to the Chamber of Commerce, Leadership Las Vegas, and the Governor's Maternal and Child Health Board. She received the Congressional Recognition, Distinguished Women of Nevada, and Outstanding Women in Politics awards, among other honors. She ran unsuccessfully for the Nevada State Senate in 1992.
