Biographical Note

Stephen Powell worked as a librarian for Special Collections at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas between 1970 and 1980. Powell created the first published gambling bibliography for Special Collections' holdings related to gaming. Along with Susan (Anderl) Jarvis, Powell developed what would become the Center for Gaming Research, a center dedicated to assisting researchers with topics across the gaming industry, including social, economic, political, and health impact studies.

Scope and Contents Note

The Stephen Powell Papers (1933-1997) contain research bibliographies, indexes, and notecards for his book, *A Gambling Bibliography: based on the Collection, University of Nevada, Las Vegas.* The collection also contains his unpublished and published manuscripts, as well as gaming pamphlets, articles, and ephemera from 1934-1977. The collection includes gambling bibliographies in foreign languages, university archive guides, catalog records, and acquisition files for research books.
