## **Biographical Note**

Dennis Gomes (1944-2012) was a regulator, gaming executive, and casino owner. He served as chief of the Audit Division for the Nevada Gaming Control Board and ended his career as the co-owner of the Resorts Casino and Hotel in Atlantic City, New Jersey. As a gaming regulator, Gomes uncovered the Stardust skim in Las Vegas, Nevada, the largest casino skim in gambling history.
